Gram Vikas Samiti: Report . 2016 to 2020

It is said that, India lives in villages! However villages in India are getting deserted very fast. Young population is attracted towards urban luxurious life and farmers are losing hopes due to unpredictable nature. The first and foremost need of villages is to improve their economical status by exposing them to various skills and tiny businesses they can adopt. The farming activity has been loss making activity for farmers and occasional Govt packages to waive off loans cannot be perpetual activity. Men folk in villages are depressed and lost all the enthusiasm in any new idea. However women in villages can be encouraged to gather their strengths and start activities to earn and support their families. So we at L.A.D. started

our work under Gram Vikas Samiti with sole aim to encourage, train and support village women folk and make them stand on their own. *In village Harankhuri*, GVS work was started in 2016. Village had a population of merely 3000 and is situated 5 km away from Katol. Women were ready to start some innovative money earning activities with minimal finances. With this in mind we focused on skill training. Training on decorating envelopes was imparted to them by our teachers and student volunteers. Decorated envelopes were later sold as gift envelopes. This activity was enjoyed and appreciated by them and they earned handsome profit on it. Approximately 300 envelopes were decorated under our guidance. Later on they took it up independently. To reduce plastic menace, we imparted them training on making of paper bags for general use and also for packaging purpose. First workshop on candle making was held for them on 17th April 2017. Demonstration on candle making was given and they were trained to make candles of various shapes and sizes. Once they gained mastery over the process 100 candles were made by them. They were also trained by our staff and students to decorate them beautifully using various decoration articles available in local market. L.A.D. College purchased many candles from them, to give as a memento for various programs in the college. A stall was also put in one of the exhibitions at katol by village ladies. Now they are carrying out this activity independently. A lecture on sustainable living was also arranged for them. NGO, Yashodhara explained them importance of organic farming, goat farming and composting activity. Lecture was attended by all the villagers. On 3rd oct 2017, we carried out a training on Phenyle and liquid soap making for the villagers and on 10th April 2018 a workshop on jewellery making and cloth bags stitching was carried out. 50 cloth bags stitched by them were sold to our acquaintances. In continuation second workshop on jewellery making was conducted on 4th oct 2018 to hone their skills. During this workshop students also trained them on latest techniques used for decoration of various articles. Many women are making various things on their own and selling in the local market or to people in their contact. During 2019-2020 we tried to train them digitally so that they can make their own videos and advertise their products. We have also started to support them to sell village delicacies. During Diwali 20 Kg of *Anarasaundi* was sold by them through our support. We wish to continue this activity of marketing various village delicacies, made by villagers in the local market to start with and then through social media or online marketing. Our students are future responsible citizens of India. Through their involvement in all the activities, they were continuously trained to help villagers to create infrastructure for improved livelihood. Students were trained to develop deeper ties with the community so that they feel obliged to act for society benefit and develop tendency to share resources available to them with the community in need.

Students also carried out healthy snacks making training for the village women, voluntarily on 16th Sept 2019, during our visit to village. Rashmi Koche, Head, Dept of FRM, Dr. Tahessen Choudhari staff of Dept of Hsc. Extension, Mrs. Kalyani Hingnikar, Contributory staff of FRM, Mr. Suman Sengupta, Professional Consultant, Dept of Applied Electronics and Mr. Rajendra Laxane support staff Seminary Hills continuously contributed and supported, all the activities of Gram Vikas Samiti.
