Uniformity is inculcated at the same time the cultural and religious and other diversities are respected and nurtured through the following measures:

NIRMAL CELL AND ITS ACTIVITIES:

Nirmal means Clean and Pure at heart. **Nirmal Cell** makes continuous efforts to instill in students a sense of unity and to inculcate values in them through different thought processes. This aim is achieved by organizing exhibition of religious books on Independence Day as 'Sarva Dharma Grantha Bhet', providing knowledge of various dharma granthas. Most religions are associated with scriptures. Apart from explaining ways to worship God, they are a rich source of information about our cultural heritage and traditions. Most value education of today is derived from these texts. For students they are like a bouquet of knowledge having wider utility and expanding dimensions about social issues science and technology.

Exposing students to the rich contents of these religious texts helps strengthen the concept of unity in diversity in our society. The students are encouraged to understand the social significance of the scriptures. The students who come from different castes, creed, communities and religious background are encouraged to browse the different texts in order to appreciate the goodness enshrined in each scripture. Students are encouraged to imbibe values in each text such as –

- The Gita (Hinduism) that teaches one to focus on selfless action
- Ramayana (Hinduism) where the focus is on ideal relationships
- The Bible (Christianity) which lends supports one when in doubt, pain
- The Qur'an (Islam) that teaches about belief and good deeds
- The Guru Granth Sahib (Sikhism) which stresses work ethics, seva and shows the way towards universal equality.
- The Tripitaka (Buddhism) that relate to discourses with the Buddha (Sutta-pitaka), regulations of monastic life (Vinaya-pitaka), and commentaries on the sutras by renowned monks and scholars (Abhidhamma-pitaka).
- Avesta of the Parsis (Zoroastrianism) whose motto is Good Thoughts, Good Words, Good Deeds
- Agam Sutras of the Jains who believe in right belief, right knowledge and right conduct.

Nirmal Cell also organizes a 'Guru Purnima Programme' as a value education activity, to create among students, awareness about the Hindu culture and traditions. The idea is to understand that the human life is given proper direction by the Guru who acts as a friend, philosopher and guide and therefore must be revered and respected.
