Meeting of IQAC of L.A.D & Smt. R.P College for Women was held on 21/11/22 at 3 .30 pm in Conference Hall, Shankar Nagar.

Item No 1.Welcome: Dr. Archana Masram - IQAC Coordinator introduced the External Nominees -Mr. Rahul Kale, Mr. Piyush Agrawal , Dr. Atya Kaple.

She accorded a warm welcome to Dr Avinash Deshmukh – Management Representative ,Officiating Principal - Dr. Pooja Pathak , Vice Principals – Dr. Kiran Patil and Dr Rijuta Bapat , IQAC Co – Coordinator – Ms. Kanchan Bade, IQAC Core Committee Members and all the Criterion Heads and External Nominees. . Ms Swaima Ahmed, Eminent Educator & Alumni was welcomed and introduced when she joined . Two student representatives Ms Tamanna Sharma - B.Com III and Ms. Sejal Ghaorode - BA III were also introduced and welcomed .

Item No. 2: **Apologies**: Apologies were received from the Criterion Heads - Dr. Bhavana Khapekar, Dr. Nanda Rathi, Dr Sangeeta Sahasrabuddhe and Registrar - Mrs. Deepika Reddiwar.

Item No 3. Address by Principal: Dr. Pooja Pathak - Officiating Principal, briefed the gathering about the formation of IQAC which was established in the year 2004 and explained its importance as a vital constituent of the institute. She stressed on the importance of External Nominees in the working of IQAC and their role at the time of NAAC Peer Team Visit.

She informed the status of 4th cycle of NAAC Accreditation Process. She explained the SSR submission system based on the Quantitative and Qualitative Metrices. She apprised the members that college has submitted the SSR on 28 July 2022 and the DVV was completed on 4 October 2022. She stated that our college has received 'A' grade in all three previous Accreditation and Assessment cycles and assured the gathering for the better performance in forthcoming cycle. She suggested all Members to be prepared for the NAAC Peer Team Visit. Madam stated that a meeting of Core committee and criteria Heads with external Nominee will be organized before the NAAC Peer Team Visit.

- 3. On 18 August 2022, DVV (Data Validation & Verification) Process was initiated & College received queries from NAAC on 19 September,2022. The deadline for the submission of responses was 4 October; 2022. Accordingly College has submitted the responses of the queries on 4 October 2022.

Item No. 7. Discussion about the Preparedness for NAAC Peer Team Visit: Criterion wise briefing about all seven criterion were given by criterion Heads and Committee Members. Criterion-1 - Dr Sumita Sapre, Criterion-2 - Dr. Deepali Chahande, Criterion-3 - Dr. Shilpa Sarode, Criterion - 4 - Kanchan Bade and Dr Shivani Balkundi, Criterion-5 - Dr Ruta Dharmadhikari, Criterion-6 - Dr Archana Masram and Criterion-7 - Ar. Surashmie Kaalmegh.

Item No. 8. Interaction by External Nominees: Dr Atya Kaple suggested that the college focus on student career building and conduct workshops for career advancement etc. She also recommended collaborative seminars, Workshops on environment sensitization and awareness with institutes like NEERI for more value addition.

Mr. Rahul Kale, External Member, IQAC, suggested preparing a Gap Analysis Plan for the holistic development of the students and college. Shri Kale spoke about creating a positive and powerful image of the institute by focusing on MOU's with industries so that it could attract more students and which could reflect on their results and career outcome. He also suggested for Criterion 2 that students be given coaching for career opportunities, engagement with well-placed Alumni, interaction with national level achievers as inspiration and application of new technology in teaching—learning process. He also suggested use of movie-like documentary format for presentation to NAAC peer team visit to showcase the achievements of the college which could be more impactful then mere PowerPoint presentation. He also reiterated that the

Gap Analysis be done and presented so as to highlight the steps taken to cover and overcome the lacunae thus found for NAAC visit purpose.

Shri Piyush Agrawal applauded the efforts of the college and thanked the college for inviting him to the forum as an external member. He spoke about boosting and concentrating for vocational training as companies look out for expertise and niche capacities and capabilities in future employees. As an example he suggested MS office which could be a certificate of 30hrs and thus more useful, Others which he suggested were financial and accounting skills using software packages, verbal and written proficiency in languages or linguistic skills, communication skills etc. He agreed with Dr Kaple on focusing on environmental issues which is the most important concern in current times and suggested a waste management and no plastic approach to be adopted on campus and adopted by all.

Ms Swaima Ahmed emphasized and spoke at length that soft skills training helps a student build self-confidence and thereby help them to be better placed and successful in the work force. She suggested that the efforts of the college in this regard could also be boosted by making CRT workshops (Campus Recruitment Training camps) on soft and hard skills mandatory rather than optional. These are lifeskills which can help in overall development of students.

Dr Avinash Deshmukh, thanked all external members for honoring the invitation and proactively interacting in the meeting and for their valuable inputs. He lauded the efforts of the Principal, Core committee and the criterion heads for the SSR and DVV preparation. He also gave his best wishes for the PTV.
