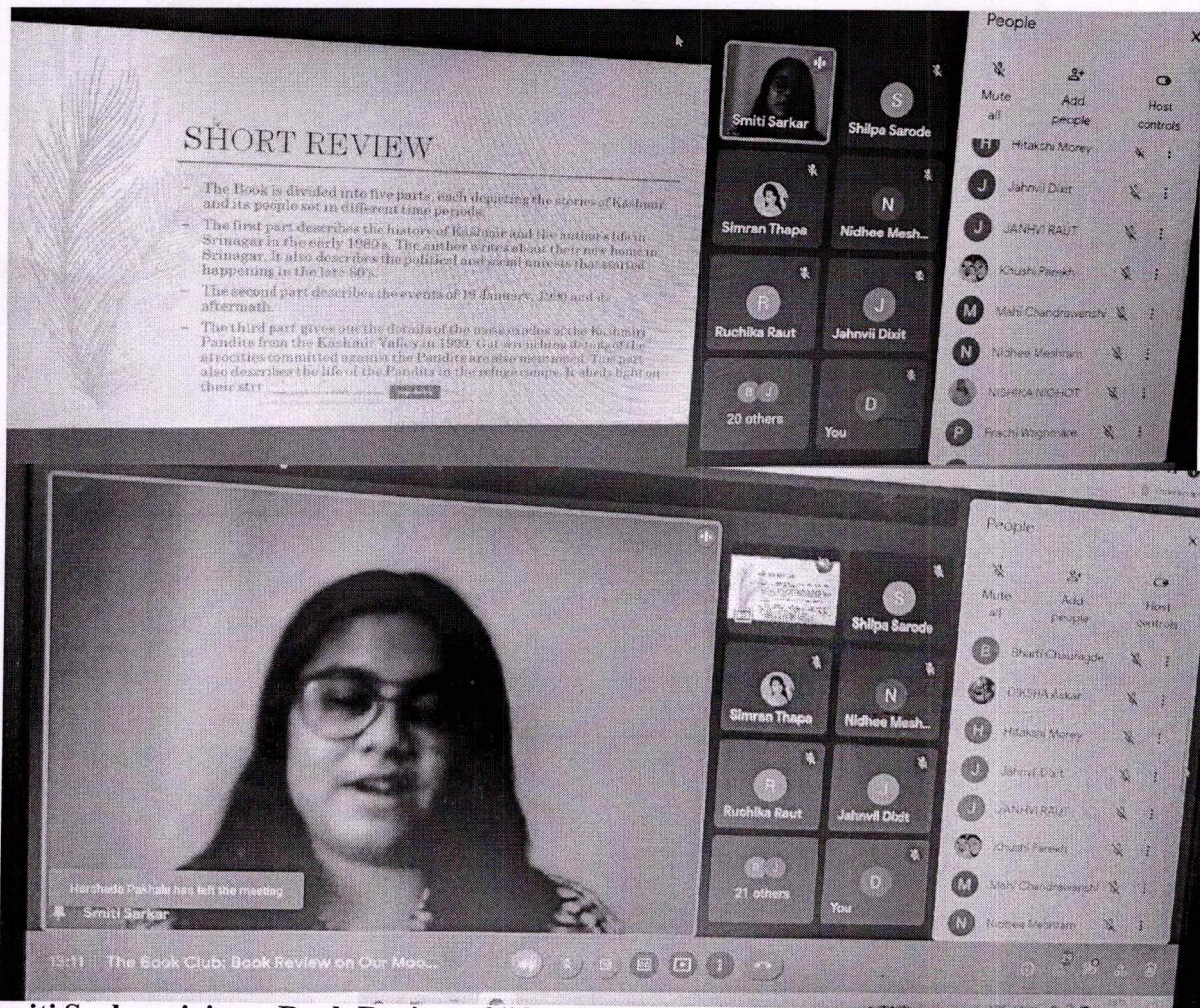

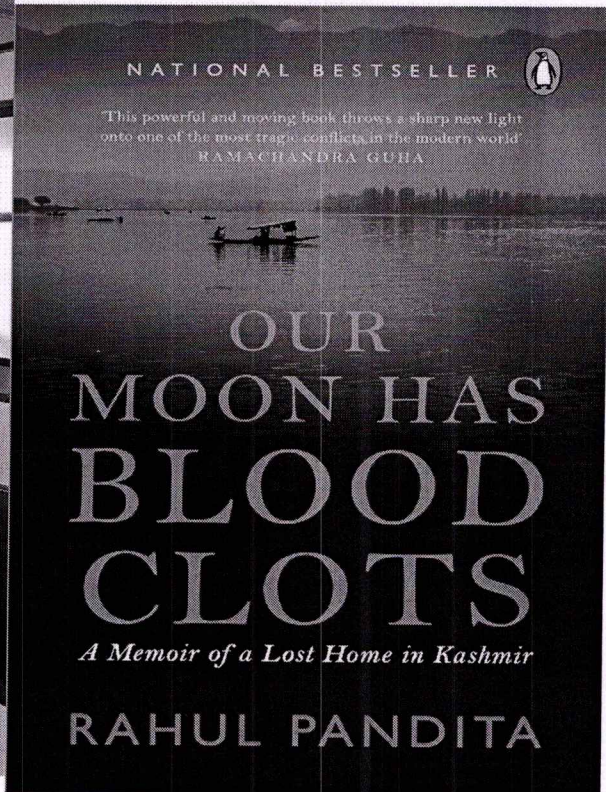
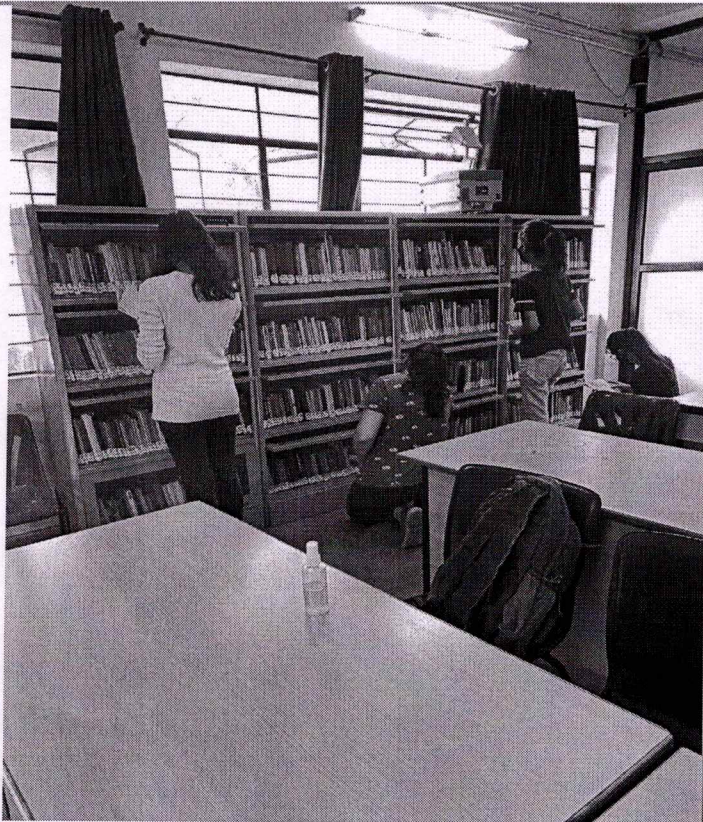

Each year a student body is formed to ensure the smooth running of the administrative responsibilities of the book club .


**WORKING PROCEDURES**



**The Book Club**

The Book Club, a venture of Department of English, had organised a book review session on 30<sup>th</sup> March 2022 as a book club activity. The presenter was Ms. Smiti Sarkar of B.A. Semester VI, English Medium. Ms. Sarkar reviewed the book "*Our Moon has Blood Clots*" by Rahul Pandita. This book, published in 2013, is a moving account of the exodus of Kashmiri Pundits from the erstwhile state of Jammu and Kashmir in 1990. Pandita's memoir is steeped in heart breaking incidents of violence and injustice.

Ms. Sarkar effectively spoke on the different themes presented in the book. Her articulation was remarkable and dignified, keeping in mind the sensitivity of the topic. Ms. Sarkar spoke of the displacement and homelessness of the Pundits, even after more than 30 years of the crisis. She accompanied her review with a crisp power point presentation and suggested a few new reads for the audience towards the concluding segment of her book review. After the session, the participants enthusiastically posed their questions to Ms. Sarkar and a healthy discussion followed.

Faculty members of the Department of English, Dr. Shilpa Sarode and Ms. Nidhee Meshram were in attendance. Ms. Neha Thosar was the moderator of the session. The book review session was held online on the Google Meet platform and was made available to students and teachers across all faculties. The total number of students who attended the session was 30.




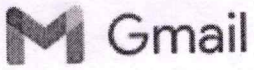

All articles published are approved by the Staff Editorial Body after careful scrutiny and review process for plagiarism and original content. The magazine discourages all and every type of plagiarism.


The magazine limits the number of articles to 25 or less.

Articles are selected for publication based on merit, originality and printworthiness. They are scrutinized and reviewed before being accepted for publication.

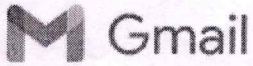

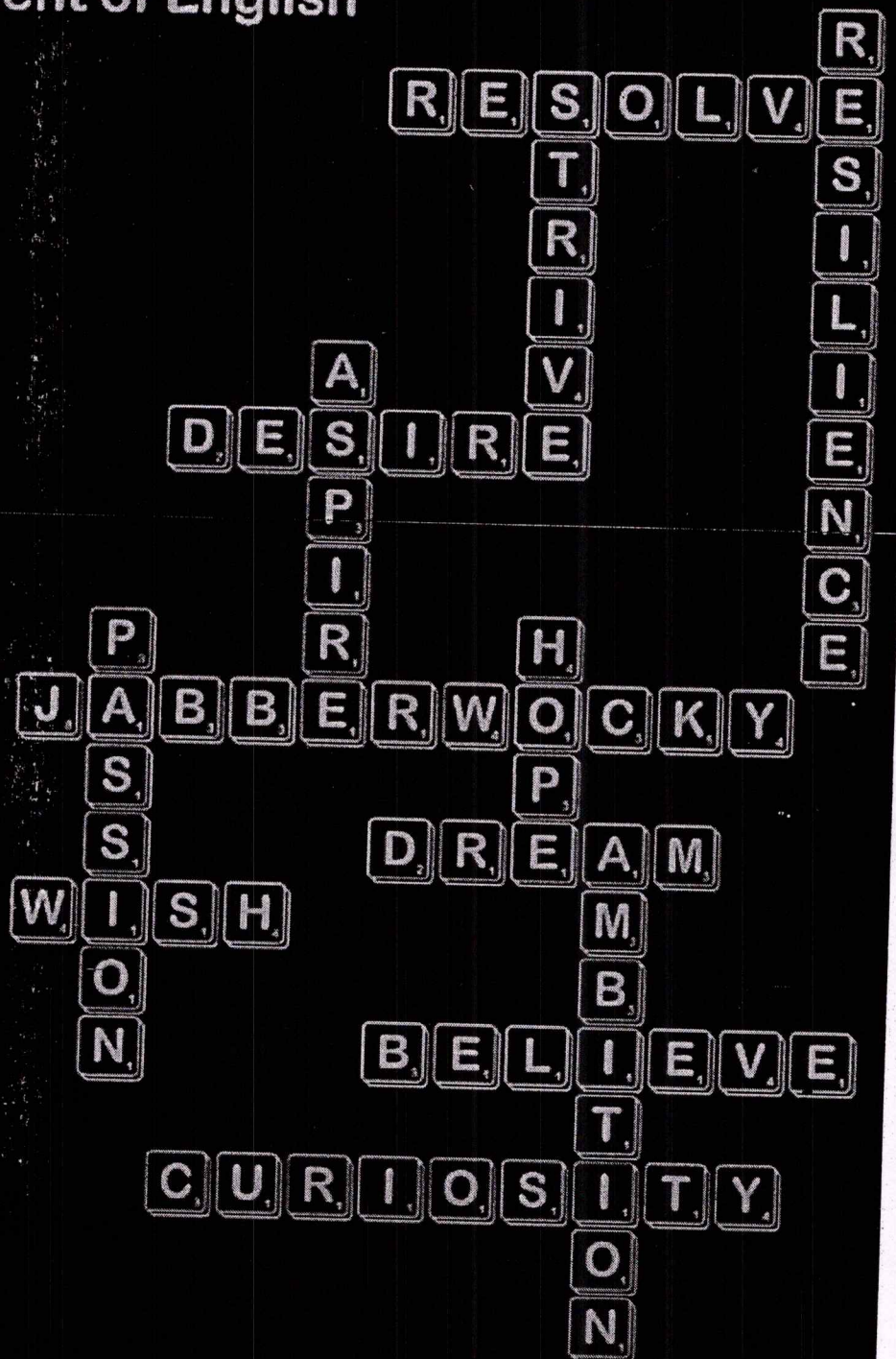

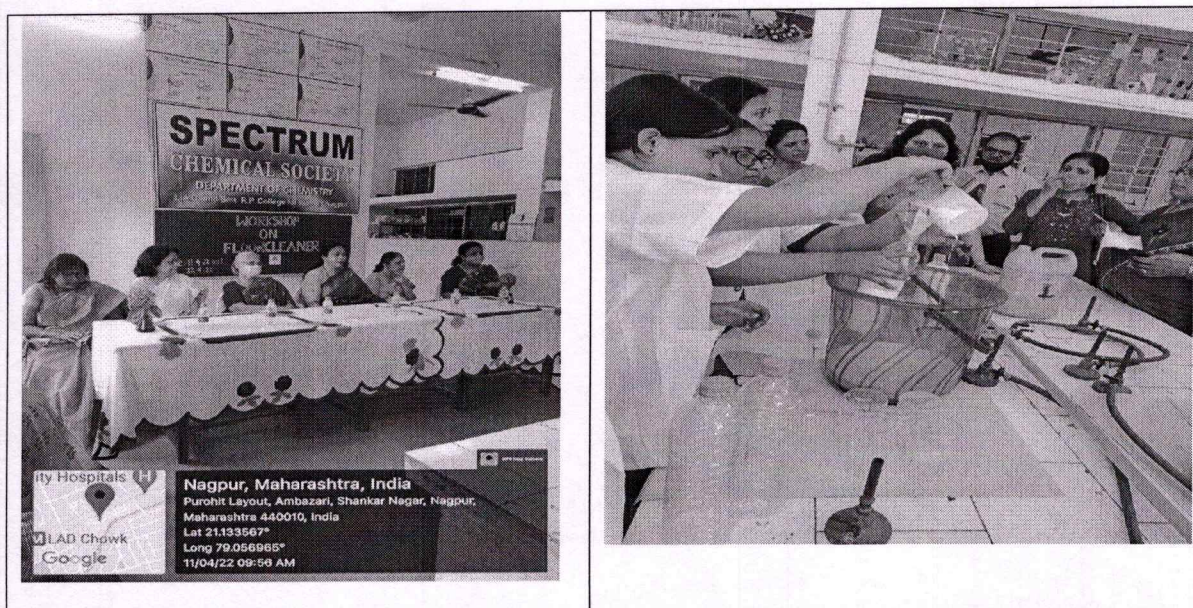
#### 4. "Spectrum" Chemical Society of Department of Chemistry

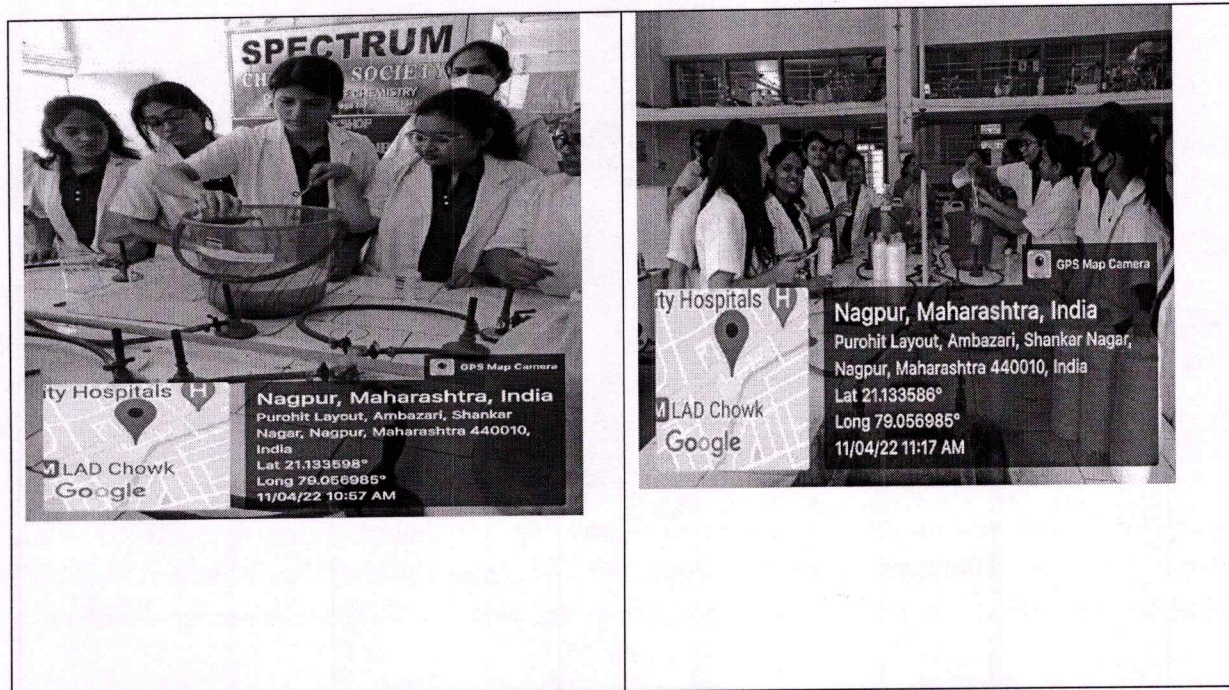
"Spectrum" is the Chemical Society of Department of Chemistry comprising of students and teachers .It conducted a Two Day Workshop on "Floor Cleaner" on 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> of April 2022 for B. Sc. Final year students under the supervision of Professor Dr. Mrs. Charita Patil Head, Department of Chemistry. Around 23 students participated in this workshop.

Dr. Mrs. Sonal Dhabekar, M.Tech, Ph.D in Cosmetic Technology and Post-Doctoral Research Fellow as Principal Investigator under Central Govt. Research Fellowship of Women Scientist Scheme, Department of Science and Technology, Govt. of India and an expert in facilitating group workshop and training was invited as a resource person for this program.

Activity carried out on first day of the workshop includes study of cost effective raw materials, preparation of the product, its packaging and labelling. Chemistry behind the process was explained by Dr. Dhabekar. She also suggested some alternatives one can make in raw materials to make the product effective and attractive. While explaining marketing strategy she point-wise explained all the variables from raw materials to costing and marketing to gain a profit as well as stability even in the small scale business.

On the second day of workshop the prepared product was kept for sale in college premises. The stall was inaugurated by Dr. Alka Dhondge, Head, Department of Biochemistry and Vice principal Shankar Nagar campus. Students explained the effectivity of product to all the visitors.100% of the prepared batch was sold.

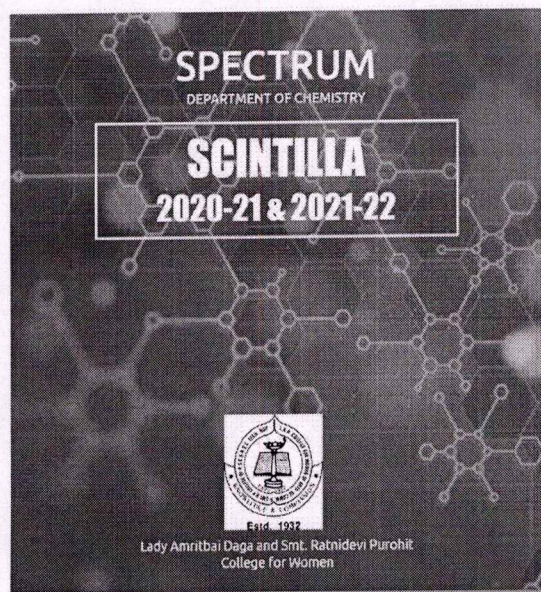

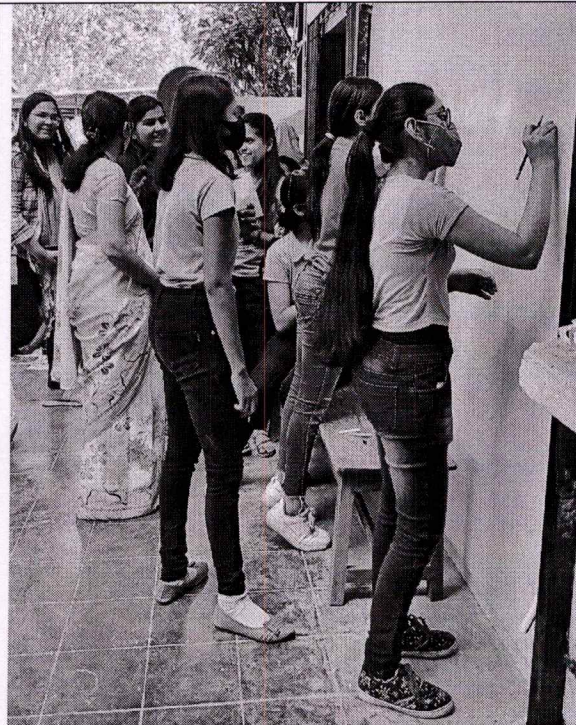


### 7. Designers' Society of the Department of Interior Design

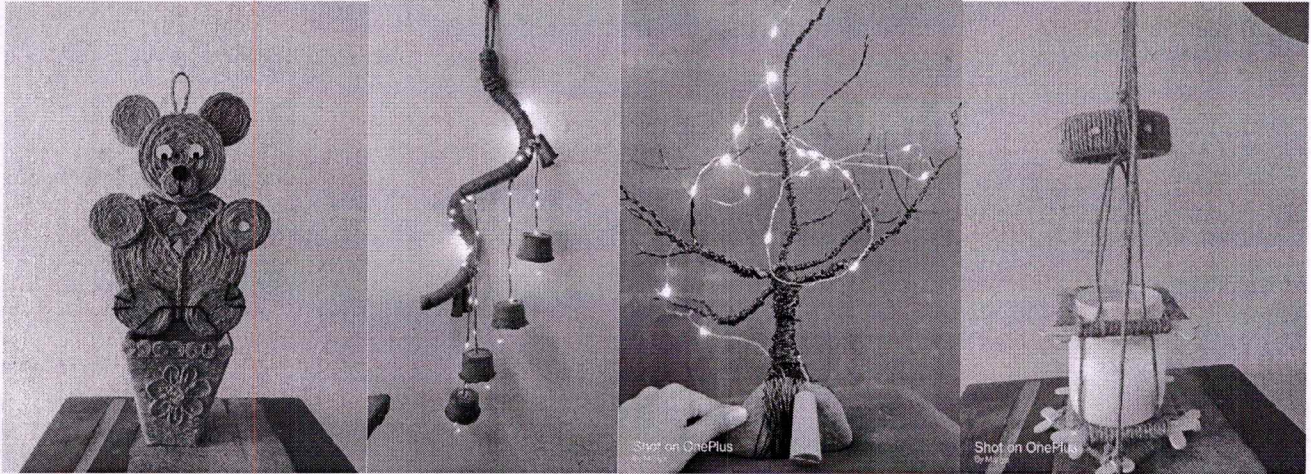

## **'Designers' Society'**

- 'Designer's Society' is a student's body supervised and monitored by a teacher in charge of Students' activity, Dr. Rijuta Bapat along with all staff members in the Department of Interior Design.
- The purpose of the 'Designers' Society' is to give students an opportunity to develop leadership by organizing and carrying out activities at departmental and college level. It also co-ordinates activities outside college viz. activities of Institute of Indian Interior Design.


