7.1.1 Measures initiated by the Institution for the promotion of gender equity

7.1.1 Annual gender sensitization action plan

The institute belonging to one of the oldest women's education society already has a practice of bringing an attitudinal and a constructive change in the society towards women and thereby focuses on equity within the institute and in the community outreach programmes. The Objective of the activities and programmes is promotion of inclusiveness, tolerance, harmony and women's empowerment among the students and staff.



Workshop on Geomorphology and Related Aspects (21-28 December 2021)

Report

Department of Geography has organized the workshop on Geomorphology and related aspects from 21st to 28th December 2021.Geomorphology-the study of landforms is the major branch of physical geography. Application of geomorphology plays important role in various fields. Keeping this thought in mind, theme of the workshop was selected for semester III students of department of Geography. This workshop covers major portion of their syllabus.

Dr. Sadhana Deshpande Former Head, Department of Geography, VNGIASS, Nagpur talked on the importance of Geomorphology on 21st December 2021. She put the picture on *Why we should study Geomorphology*? After discussing basics of geomorphology, she discussed philosophical approach of geomorphology and its importance for personality development. She associated various geomorphic processes with the philosophy of life in a very beautiful way.

Dr. V. Gajghate Assistant Professor, Department of Geography, Rabindrnath Tagore college of Arts, Commerce and Science, Dongargaon, Nagpur was the resource person on 22nd December 2021.He talked about *Drainage of Maharashtra* in association with the physical divisions of the region. He explained different river basins of Maharashtra using very detailed maps. Major drainage patterns of the region were also discussed by him.

Dr. Y. Y. Dudhapachare, Associate Professor and Head, Department of Geography, Janata Mahavidyalaya, Chandapur shared his expertise views on the *Application of Geomorphological Knowledge for the Development of Maharashtra* on 23rd December 2021. Initially he gave evidences of geomorphic knowledge applied by Gond kings and Shivaji Maharaj in Maharashtra. He quoted many examples to explain association of Geomorplogy and economy of any region. Aspects like rainfall, Agriculture, Irrigation projects, Crops, Transportation facilities, Disasters associated with Geomorphology of Maharashtra was well explained by him.

On 24th December 2021, Dr. Raju Gawre Assistant Professor, Department of Geography, H. J. Thim College, Jalgaon explained the *Relief features associated with running water-A case study of Maharashtra* in an interactive session. He explained the work of running water and landforms associated with various processes involved in it. He used diagrams and videos to explain all the associated landforms. He also shown some landforms using Google Earth engine. Different stages of




river as an agent of erosion were also explained. His talk has revised the major portion of Geomorphology syllabus.

Dr. Kaveri Dabhadkar, Assistant Professor (Selection grade), Department of Geography,

Govt. Bilasa Girls PG College, Bilaspur (CG) shared her experience on *Geomorphology and Tourism* on 27th December 2021.She elucidated the novel concept of Geotourism, Geodiversity and Geoheritage. She focussed light on various landforms and tourist places of Chhattisgarh state with special reference of Bastar region. Participants got good knowledge about various tourist places and their association with geomorphology. Students were also motivated to do research in this field by her lecture.

On 28th December 2021learning activities were arranged for students. Quiz was conducted to know the learning of participants from the workshop. Map preparation activity was given to the students based on various geomorphic units. Lastly feedback was taken from the participants.

Overall, all the resource persons shared their rich and real-life experiences related with the theme of the workshop with the participants.Students were benefitted by this academic endeavour. Approximately 35students participated in this workshop. Dr. Prachiti Bagaday was the convenor of the workshop. Dr. Deepali Chahande, Head of the department of Geography guided for the success of this educational activity.

Convention on Career with Geography

The department of Geography has organised a Convention on **Career with Geography** in collaboration with Alumnae Association from 26-27 November 2021.

The convention was mainly organised for B A semester-I students of geography, but other students of the department also participated in it. This event also covers a small portion of the syllabus. The main objective of the convention was that the students in the initial stage should get acquainted with modern technology-Remote Sensing (RS) and Geographic Information System (GIS) which is an inseparable part of geography.

Dr. Alka Dhondge, Vice Principal, Shankar Nagar and Dr. Vaikhari Wazalwar, Co-convener Alumnae Association were prominently present. Dr Alka Dhondgeke gave the introductory speech in which she inspired the students to carefully go through the convention, so that they will get right direction for their career and accordingly students will be able to shape their future.

Dr. Mrunmayee Lokhande, Former Sr. RS & GIS ASSOCIATE (consultant), Maharashtra Remote Sensing Applications Center (MRSAC), Nagpur delivered an Interactive talk on Career in RS and GIS on 26.11.2021. She told Geography is a parent science for all other disciplines. She introduced the basic concepts of Remote Sensing and GIS techniques. With various maps toposheets, satellite imageries, Geo-reference maps- explain the application of geographical knowledge in all the sectors. She guided the students to go for additional certificate or degree or diploma courses in RS and GIS, Then n- number of career options are open for geographers.. At present in each and every department experts in RS and GIS are required such as in Agriculture Department, Water Department, Urban and Rural Planning, Forestry Department, and much more. Apart from this RS and GIS is used in Health Sector, Disaster Management, Law and Enforcement, Crime Department, Survey Department, Land records etc. With technical development, field monitoring is also done by drones. She mentioned some of the prominent institutions for RS and GIS courses.

Ms. Mitina Upwanshi, Artificial Intelligence ASSOCIATE GIS, Techcamellia, Banglore, Initially told about geographical tools such as field surveys, maps, satellite imageries, GIS, GPS. She also talked about skills and attributes of geographers which includes intellectual skills, practical skills, interpersonal skills and personal skills.


She explained in detail about career options in geography and eligibility requirements for those. 
Both the resource persons were the Alumnae of the department. Overall they guided the students for ample career opportunities in geography.








Garima Week Celebrations: 15 JULY :




Guest Lecture on "Women's Rights" on 28th March 2022 organized by Jagruti & Bulandi Cell

Deep Daan (Candle Making) on 02 October 2021:

NSS Unit II organized 'Deep Daan - Candle Making Workshop' for the volunteers on 2 October 2021 at 4:30 p.m. on Google Meet platform. Resource Person was Mr. Suman Sengupta, Visiting Faculty, and Department of Applied Electronics. He demonstrated the making of candles of different shapes and sizes, multicolored and scented. He also gave information about the wax and various moulds available in the market. The wax is melted at 70 degree Celsius and therefore precaution should be taken while pouring it in the mould. The wax becomes hard after cooling and can be removed from the mould.
