

REPORT OF THE SOFT SKILLS CERTIFICATE COURSE 1 APRIL 2023-2 MAY 2023

The Department of English of L.A.D. and Smt. R. P. College for Women organized a 30-hour Soft Skills Certificate Course from 1 April 2023 to 2 May 2023. This course was conducted under the aegis of SkEd. The Soft Skills Certificate Course is designed to equip the students with set of skills, where each module focuses on the concepts of Communication, Awareness of Self and the World, Critical Thinking and Leadership Strategies, which are required to succeed and excel in today's world.

The Certificate Course was inaugurated by the Principal Dr. Pooja Pathak, where she encouraged the participants and organizers with her words of motivation. In her inaugural address, she spoke of the importance of effective communication and leadership skills and how they would be important tools for the aspiring young minds of the participants. Dr RutaDharmadhikari was the Course Coordinator and Dr Meenakshi Kulkarni was the Convener.

This course falls outside the prescribed syllabus of RTMNU, of their undergraduate studies and is administered as an additional skill development course. These skills are imparted to the students through their interaction with skilled resource persons from all walks of life. The course has been conceptualized over a 30hour schedule, each session is of 90 minutes, comprises 5 modules and a total of 22 sessions, with one being a feedback session.

The Course had more than 50 students registered through the Google Form as well as offline in the Department of English. An attendance registered was regularly maintained for the participants. While the sessions were moderated by Dr Ruta Dharmadhikari and Dr Meenakshi Kulkarni, Ms. Neha Thosar created online feedback forms for each session, which were filled up by the students daily.

The first module dealt with the concept of 'Communication'. The inaugural session was conducted by Dr.Ruta Dharmadhikari who spoke on the topic 'Basics of Communication and the Importance of Precise 'Communication'. She further elaborated on the importance of clarity in communication. Through her talk, she briefly touched upon concurring modules and gave the students a slice of what was to come in consecutive sessions.

The second session was delivered by Anil Jain on the topic "Body Language, Silence and Empathetic Communication". He elaborated on the importance of non-verbal communication and the importance of silence in communication

The next session was conducted by Dr.Prantik Banerjee on "Competitive English". During his session he shared various valuable tips with the participants on how to prepare for competitive exams. The participants interacted freely with the resource person at the end of the session.

The last session saw Ms. Simran Thakwani elaborate on an important contemporary topic titled "Content Writing for Digital Media". Ms. Thakwani stressed on the importance of creating a personal brand value and contextual repurposing for maximum impact. This session would surely help our young participants make their mark in the digital world.

The second module of the course was titled 'The Self and the World'. The first session of the second module was conducted by Course Convener Dr.Meenakshi Kulkarni. She spoke on "Managing Your Emotions", a topic that resonated deeply with the participants as today's rapidly changing world takes a toll on the youngsters' emotion management skills.

In the second session Dr. Kanak Gillurkar Sharma spoke on "Anxiety Management: Coping with Pressure". Her topic was a logical follow up of the previous session and furthered the concepts of managing pressures and anxiety.

Following on the trope of managing emotions and pressure, Ms Sucheta Doo enlightened the participants on the topic "Good Stress, Bad Stress'. Her session was interactive and thoroughly enjoyed by the participants.

The concluding session of this module was a master class by Dr Suresh Chari on "Interpersonal Skills and Peer Group Dynamics". He stressed on the importance of positive thinking, adaptability and discipline. This session was an apt conclusion to the second module as it gave the students practical understanding of attributes required in the industry set-up and the importance of positive peer group dynamics.

'Critical Thinking' was the focus of the third module. The first session was conducted by Dr.Arvinder Kaur on the topic "Critical Thinking and Problem Solving" where she spoke on the importance of breaking stereotypical thinking patterns and how it forms an essential part of the problem-solving technique. Her delivery was effortless and immersive.

Dr.Rashmi Bansal conducted a much-needed session on "Time Management and Goal Setting', which was much appreciated by the young participants.

The third session of this module saw Dr.Medha Dixit discussing about "Assertive Skills and Conflict Management". Dr. Dixit shed light on the importance of approaching a conflict in a positive and assertive manner to reduce hassles and issues. She also spoke about importance of and techniques in practicing difficult discussions beforehand.

This session was particularly enjoyed by the students' as it was an interactive session where input and feedback of the participants was discussed in great detail.

Maitreyee Kale was the resource person for the second session titled "Community Outreach and Communication". Ms. Kale explained the importance of listening skills in effective communication.

Aditi Jain conducted a stimulating session on "How to Tackle Gender Discrimination". She enumerated various steps a person may take in ensuring gender equality. She engaged the participants with various activities and interacted effectively with the participants.

The final session of this module saw the renowned Dr.Atya Kaple interacting with the participants on "Women in Leadership". It was a highly informative session for budding young professionals stepping out into the real world. Dr.Kaple spoke of her own experiences and how women empowerment played a role in making women great leaders.

The fifth and final module dealt with "Communication Strategies". The first session was conducted by Mr. Tanveer Mirza who spoke on "Communicating with my Environment". His session dealt with climate change and the importance of 'action'. He actively encouraged the participants to be more environment conscious in their daily lives.



CERTIFICATE COURSE IN CALLIGRAPHY

The Department of Interior Design organized a fifteen day certificate course in Calligraphy from 5/09/2022 to 26/09/2022 for first year students of Bachelor of Interior Design. The duration of the workshop was two hours per day for fifteen days as per the time table. A total number of sixteen students registered for the workshop.

The art of lettering is an important skill desired in the field of interior design. All drawings done by the students of interior design need lettering on them. Text is an integral part of all drawings. Lettering skill is hence an essential skill required by all designers.

The outcome of the workshop was skill development in various types of letter types written manually. The syllabus of the workshop included fifteen different types of fonts like Gothic, City Blue Print, and Country Blue Print to name a few. A stationery kit containing Calligraphy pens, workbook and notebook etc was provided to all participants. The workbook containing all the 15 fonts was part of the kit. 

Course incharge- Dr. Ashwini Balki



- > The observations were photographed and pasted on their scrap book



SKED Workshop

Faculty of Commerce & Management Report on Skill-Education (SkEd Level I) Certificate Course ON "FINANCIAL AWARENESS AND INVESTMENT PLANNING"

The Faculty of Commerce & Management of L.A.D. & Smt. R.P. College for Women, Nagpur had organized a week long Skill-Education (SkEd Level I) wrokshop on "Financial Awareness And Investment Planning" in the Conference Hall of the college. The course initiated under the guidance of Dr. Pooja Pathak, Principal & Dr. Bhavana Khapekar, Head, Faculty of Commerce & Management & Co-ordinator of the program. SkEd aims to satisfy the core needs of students, recent graduates and experienced professionals. Inauguration of the course was held on 13 March, 2023. Dr. Kiran Patil, Vice Principal and Dr. Bhavana Khapekar felicitated the Chief Guest, Mr. Shailesh Sandel, Faculty of Money Bee Institute Pvt. Ltd, Nagpur. Dr. Bhavana Khapekar, Head, Faculty of Commerce and Management and Co-ordinator, encouraged the students to participate actively in the workshop. Introductory remarks were made by Dr. Madhuri Chansarkar, Convenor of SkEd Level I.

In all 128 students and 16 faculty members registered for the course. The entire fraternity of Commerce and Management worked hard for the success of the event.





13 March 2023, first day of SkEd Level I was addressed by Mr. Shailesh Sandel. He briefly introduced the concept of primary and secondary market and the ways to enter the stock market by opening a savings, trading and demat account. He also explained about the securities market and methods of investments in securities market. He shared some examples explaining the importance of time value of money and the formula of power of compounding. A video on stock market before 1980s was shared to get an idea about the buying and selling of shares in 1980s.

14 March 2023, second day of SkEd Level I was continued by Mr. Shailesh Sandel. He explained students' importance of saving and its impact on starting at early age. He discussed about concept of price discovery market, deciding the face value of product, private payment, public offer, cut off price, risk factor, buyback, Merchant Bank, etc.

15 March 2023, third day of SkEd Level I was taken Ms. Shivani Dani, Financial consultant, trainer, Money Bee Institute and youngest trainer at NISM. She explained right from the basics of mutual funds followed by detailed and practical explanation of equity market and financial investments options. She also explained about Asset Under Management (AUM), RTA, SIP, market capitalization, etc. The session was very interactive and interesting.

SKED Workshop

16 March 2023, fourth day of SkEd Level I was continued by Ms. Shivani Dani. The speaker started by reviewing the homework assigned to the participants on the previous day, which was to research about CIBIL and bank interest rates. After that, she provided a brief and its significance in explained the participants about different investment terms, such as NFO (New Fund Offer), financial planning. Ms. Mutual Fund Unit, AMC (Asset Management Company), AUM (Asset Under Management), and NAV (Net Asset Value). She gave examples and explained how each of these terms is essential in mutual fund investments. She explained about various investment pattern of mutual funds. She highlighted the various sectors of mutual funds such as equity, debt, hybrid, and solution-oriented funds. She also talked about the risk and return associated with each type of fund and how to choose the right fund based on investment goals and risk appetite.

17 March 2023, fifth day of SkEd Level I was taken by Mr. Shailesh Sandel. He discussed about Price Band & Cut off Price, ASBA-Application Supported by Blocked Market, Listing of Companies & Securities, IPO-Initial Public Offer, ISIN-International Security in Number, Stock Exchanges and its listing, DRSP Report, etc. Excel formulas such as the XIRR and the

Power of Compounding were also thoroughly explained.

18 March 2023, sixth day of SkEd Level I was taken by Mr. Shailesh Sandel. The final day of the workshop started with the concept of tax. Two type of Taxes, Direct and Indirect Tax were explained. He also enlightens students about income tax returns and the importance of income tax returns. The students positively answered to the questions by the speaker and got to know much about taxes. He also reviewed all concepts discussed on previous days.



At the end of the programme, online feedback of SkEd Level I was taken. Feedback Session was open for student participants & staff. Representative from M.Com, B.Com, B.B.A. & B.C.C.A gave individual feedback on each session. They shared that they gained practical knowledge about Stock Market, Mutual Funds, On-line trading, etc. and learnt many ways to invest money. They felt more confident and enthusiastic to build their career in investment related fields. Teachers suggested students to participate more in such events. Dr. Madhuri Chansarkar was appreciative of the orderly way course was arranged and motivated students for further participation. All other teachers of Faculty of Commerce & Management were also present.
