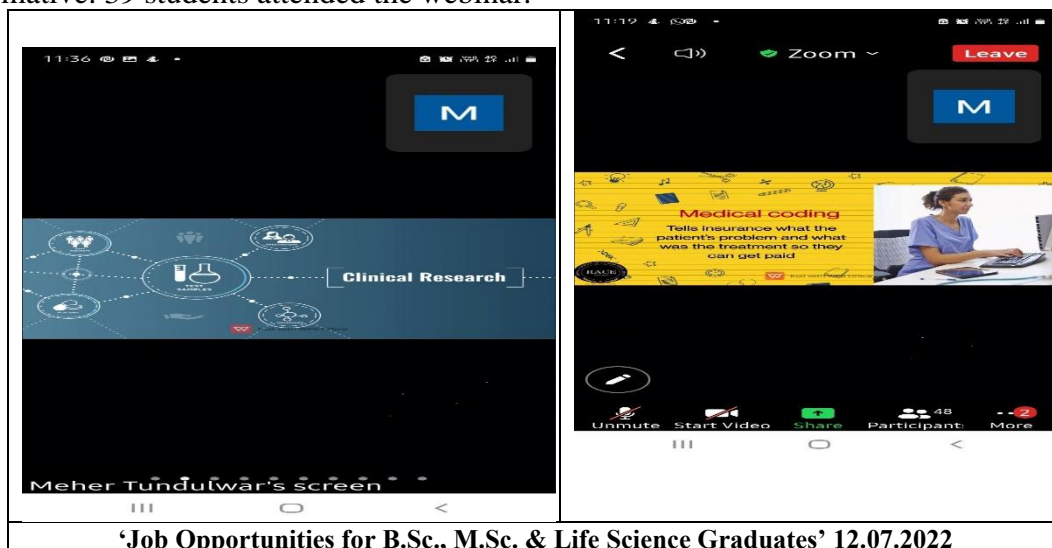

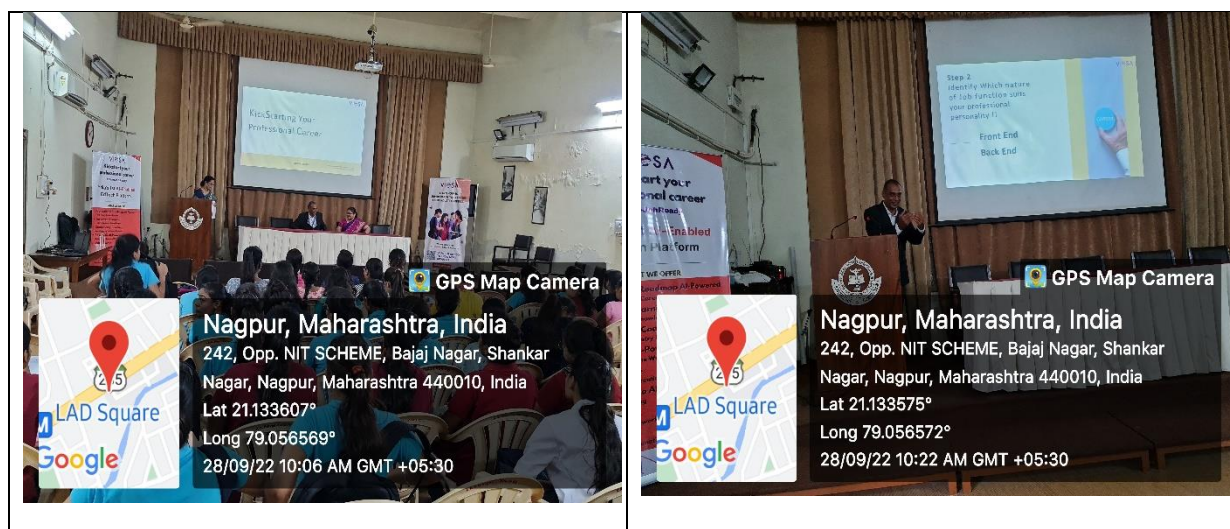

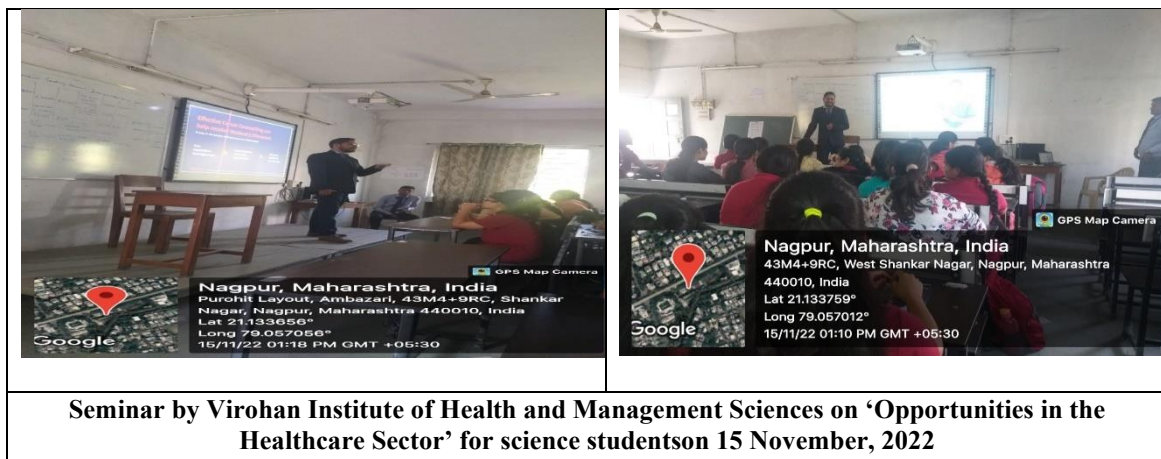
**Seminar by Virohan Institute of Health and Management Sciences

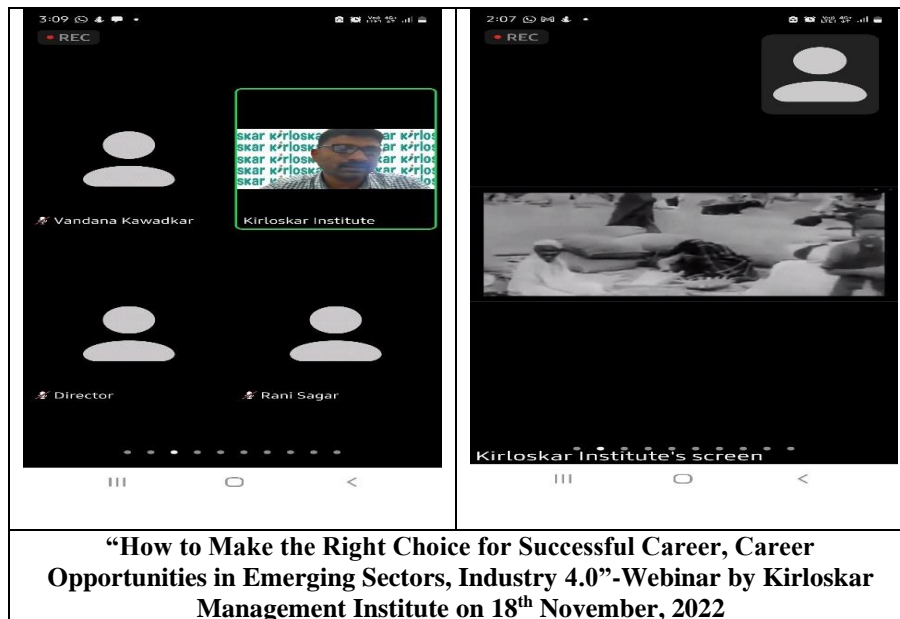

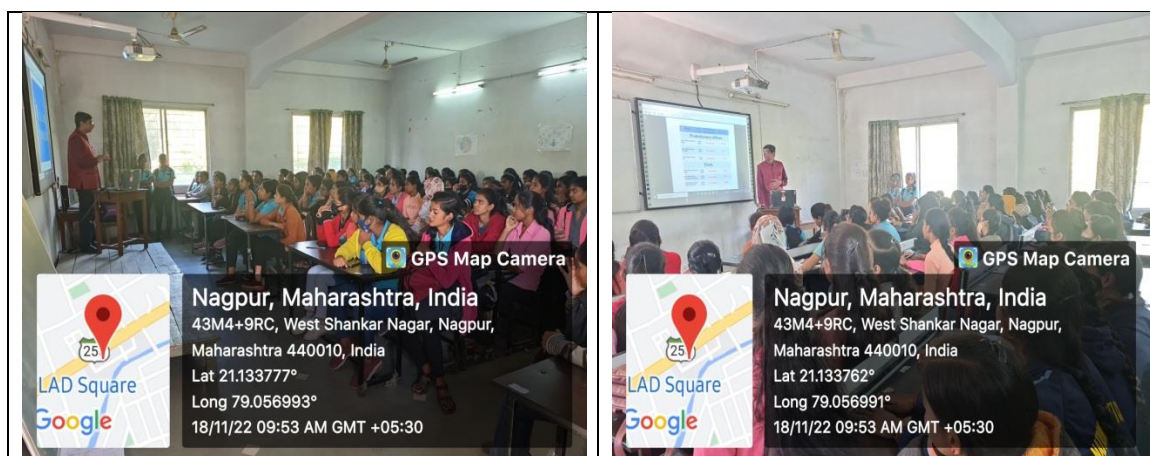

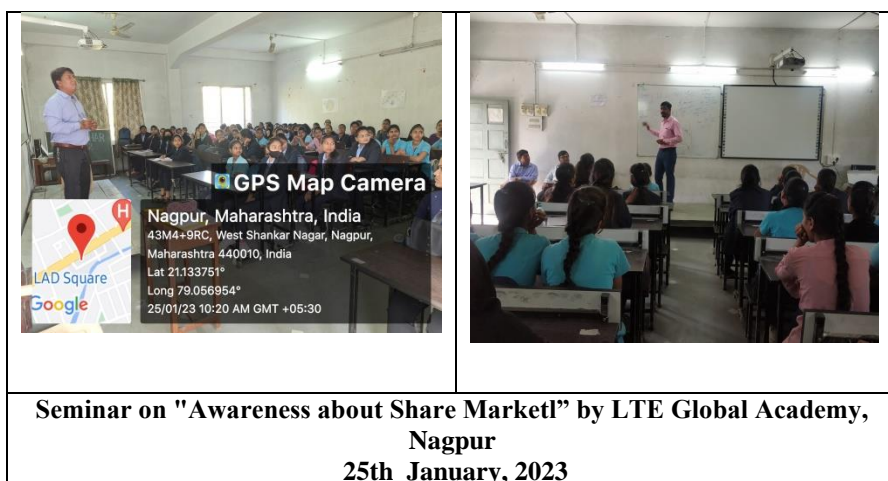
