STUDENTS' QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL  
STUDENT INDUCTION PROGRAMME

The Students' Quality Assurance Cell of the college conducted the Student Induction Programme (SIP) for all the first-year students from all the faculties, from 20<sup>th</sup> – 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2022, in the Justice B.S. Niyogi Hall at the Shankar Nagar Campus. The three-day programme was in keeping with the Deeksharambh initiative of the UGC and conducted along the guidelines stated in the NEP. The SIP is an important and active pedagogy of inculcating a feeling of belongingness and ownership of the college among the students. Various sessions were organized which helped students to know the various aspects of their college, as well as their place, role and duties in the community and society that they live in.

Day 1: The SIP was inaugurated by Officiating Principal Dr. Pooja Pathak by lighting the traditional lamp. In her inaugural address, Dr Pooja Pathak, welcomed the new students to the college. She blessed them with many words of encouragement and motivation. She dwelt briefly on the culture of the institution, its glorious history and the rich benefits that the students will have in the coming years.

Dr Vaikhair Wazalwar, Co convenor of the SQAC conducted the inaugural Programme.

Next, Dr Ruta Dharmadhikari, Convenor, SQAC gave a PowerPoint Presentation on the various aspects of L.A.D College. She gave a comprehensive overview of NAAC and IQAC, NEP as well as the various college committees, cells, academic and extracurricular activities that the college offered to all students.



The first session was held by Dr Vathsala Srinivas on 'My Society, My Responsibility' in which she familiarized the students with the concepts of punctuality, campus engagement, interaction amongst students, boosting self-esteem, exploring and expressing one's abilities, and growing together. The session concluded with 'We are all a part of society and are responsible to make it happier and healthier'. This was a very important session which reinforced the purpose of the SIP- to create awareness among students about their college values and principles which are roots towards building a healthy and happy personality.

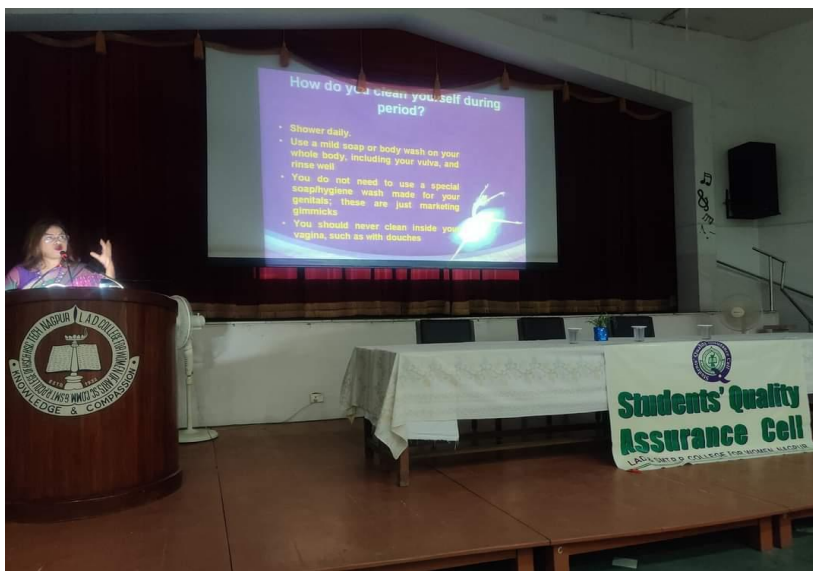
The programme was then followed by Dr Nidhee Meshram's informative presentation on 'Swachha Bharat: Loo Manners for a Happy Washroom'. As Convenor of the SEWA Cell of the college, she told the students about the community welfare projects that are held in the college, concluding on the note of the cleanliness of washrooms and menstrual hygiene. She gave a very effective PPT on how to use a washroom, toilet and how it was the user's responsibility to keep it clean. This session was invaluable as it reminded students that it was their responsibility to keep all washrooms hygienically clean as also their surroundings.

Day 2: Dr Vaidehi Marathe, OB-GYN specialist spoke on “Safety and Security of a Woman’s Body: Menstrual Hygiene”. She educated the students on a variety of aspects related to the importance of menstrual hygiene as well as the need to minimize the taboo surrounding menstruation, unwanted pregnancy, sexually transmitted diseases (STDs). Also, she advised the students to get a certain amount of light exercise every day. The students posed many questions regarding PCOD, irregular periods, how effective is a menstrual cup, green periods etc. Dr Marathe’s presentation was very well received by all the students.

Nilima Waghmare from the Department of Sports and Physical Education conducted the next session. She informed the students about the various alumnae of LAD College who, through NCC had participated in the Republic Day parades. She emphasized on the importance of exercise and how the college conducts various sports camps for students all year round. After hearing about her achievements and experiences as a coach to many great players, the students are looking forward to the sports opportunities and facilities provided by the college. Mrs Waghmare opened up a new way of looking at Sports and encouraged the students to play at least one game every day.

The concluding session was conducted by Dr Ahinsa Tirpude, Department of Music. She spoke on the essence of music and how it serves to be 'the food of life'. She informed the students about Hindustani Classical Music, as being the base for all types of music. She also made the students participate in a



small exercise of deep breathing and chanting 'Om' and gave examples of many retro Bollywood songs such as 'Ek Pyaar Ka Nagma Hai', 'Mera Saaya Saath Hoga', of how they come under Raag Yaman of Hindustani Classical Music. Dr Tirpude concluded the session by singing a beautiful prayer, 'Humko Mann Ki Shakti Dena', along with a couple of famous Bollywood songs on the student audience's demand.

Day 2 ended on a fulfilling note and the students were dispersed for the registration for the different cells and committees of the college.

Day 3: On the final day of the Induction programme, Dr Farhat Daud alumna of the Department of Cosmetology and also a faculty there was invited to talk to the students on an aspect of health and hygiene. She engaged the student audience with her captivating seminar on 'Personal Grooming: Health and Hygiene through Skin and Hair Care'. She started off sharing with everyone some basic knowledge of our skin, its composition, skin types, why skincare and grooming is important, and maintenance of the pH level of the skin. She gave the students valuable tips on skin and hair care and maintaining an ideal routine suitable to one's skin type.



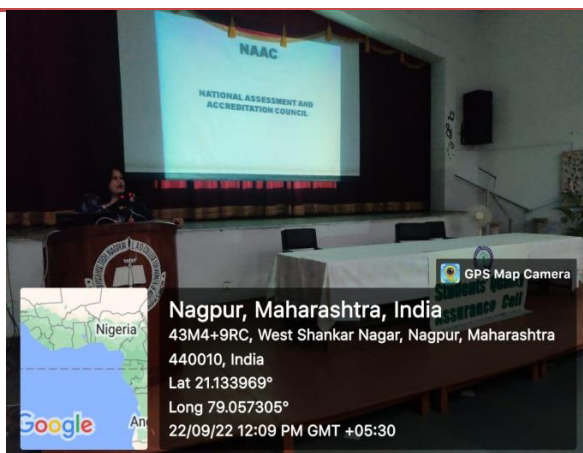


The following guidelines are to be followed as long as the event takes place (as it is intended to be perennial):


- The CC and the OC *must* be selected from the student populace by the students.



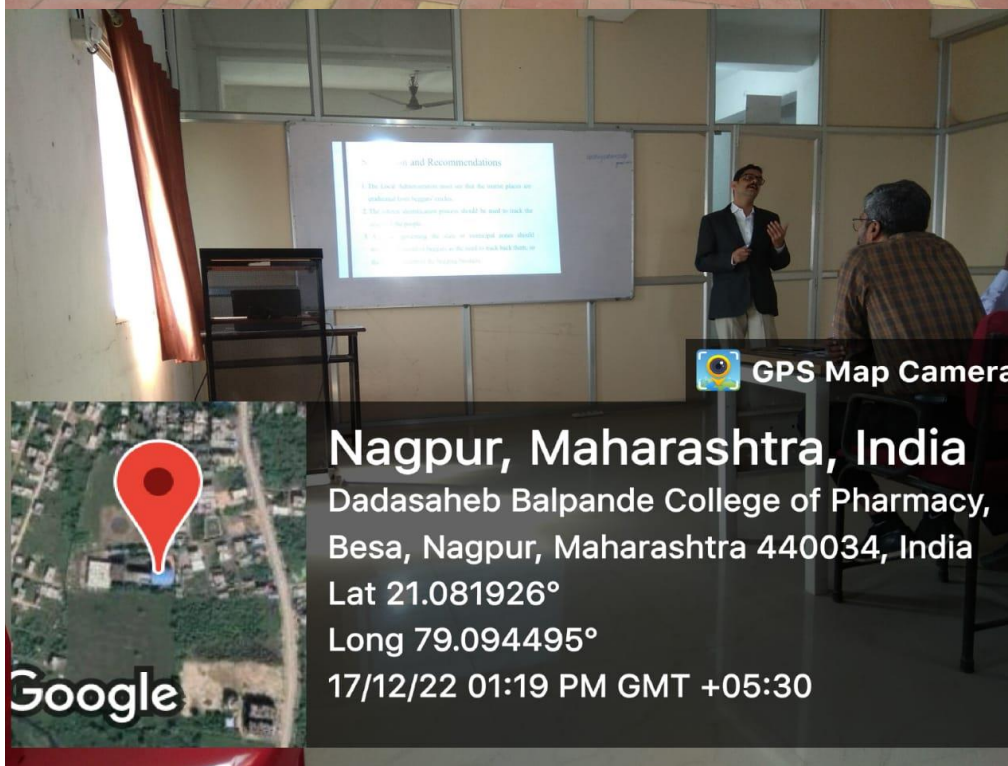

37 students of B.Com II, B.Sc. III, B.A.III, BA II and BA I attended the review.

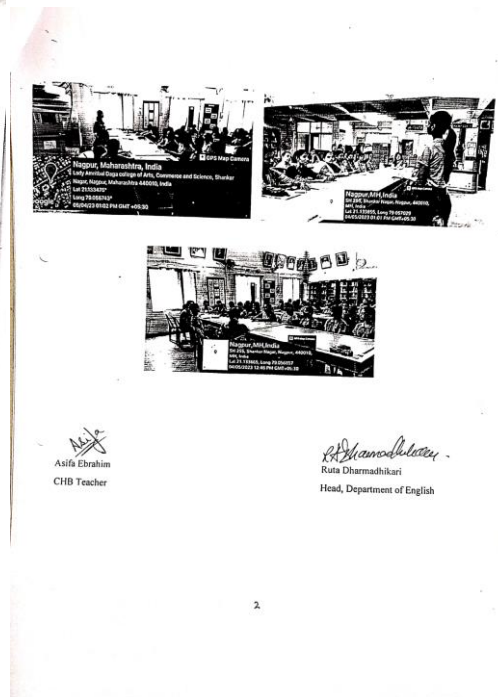
