

Annual Report Of Credit Cooperative Society









2. The college encourages staff members to apply for medical reimbursements and they are granted as per government rules.

In 2022-2023 Kiran Nasery was granted medical reimbursement.








Dr. Pooja Pathak, Officiating Principal Inuded the efforts of all the Teaching and Non - teaching staff for NAAC SSR documentation.
