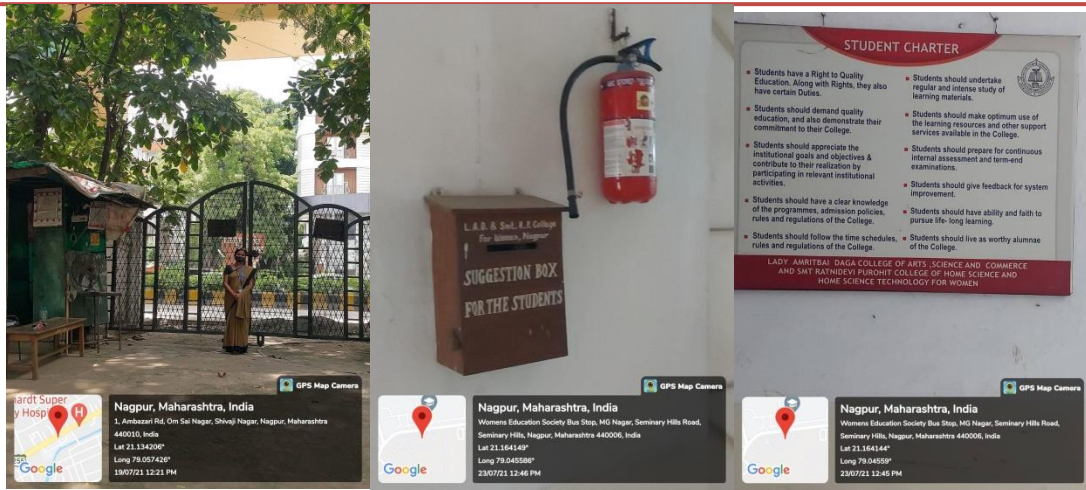

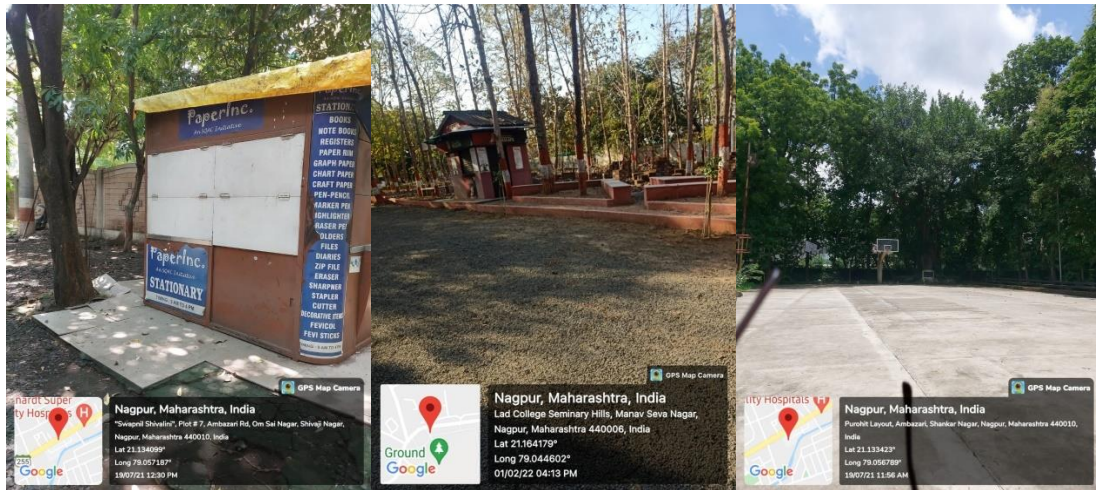

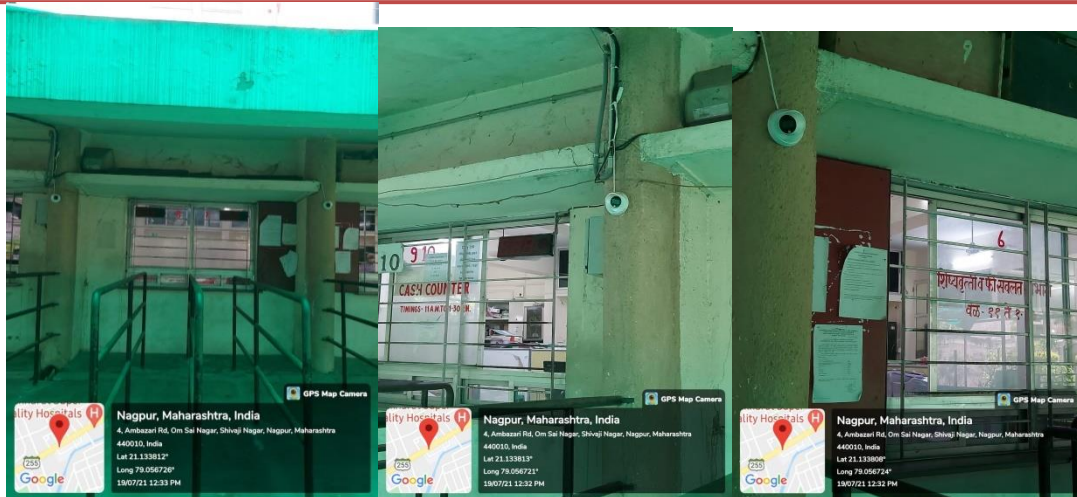

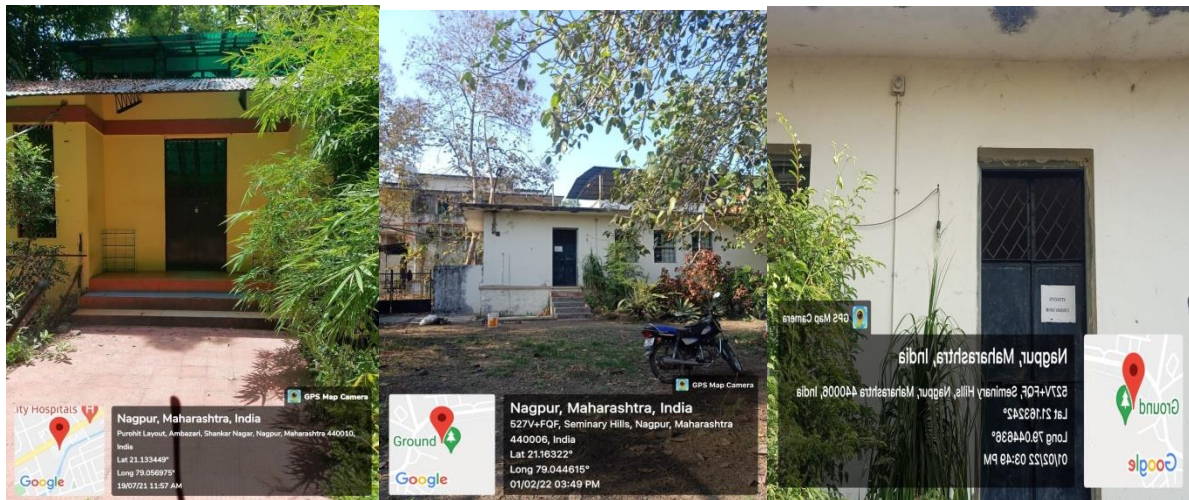

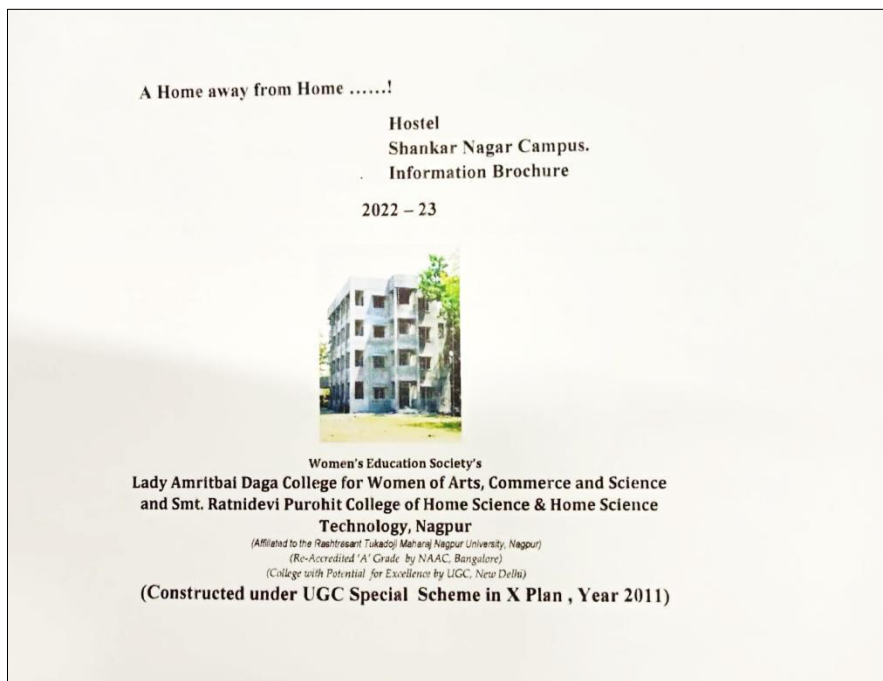

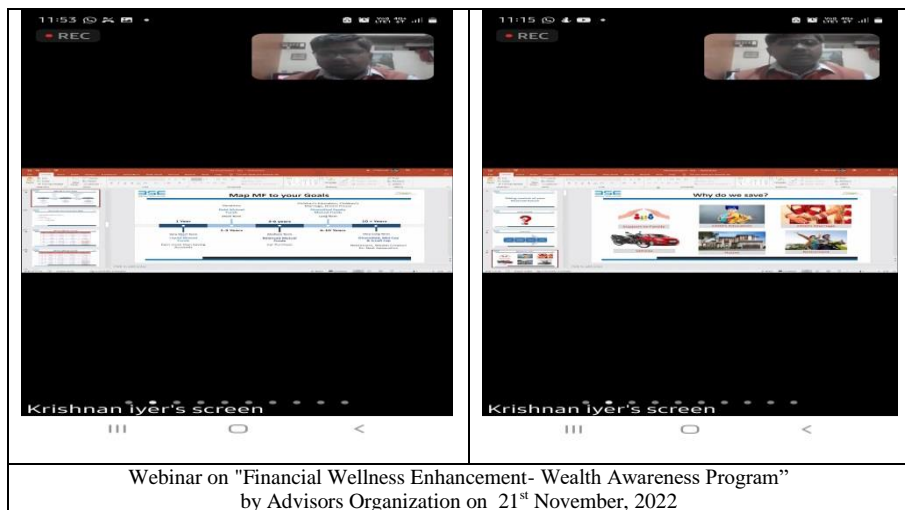
Webinar on "Financial Wellness Enhancement- Wealth Awareness Program"

**Skin Care Awareness Camp**





On 25<sup>th</sup> of August 2022 Thursday there was a Skin Care Awareness Camp organized by the Department of Cosmetic Technology at D.J Deshmukh hall, L.A.D College, Seminary Hills, Nagpur from 11am onwards by Dr. Shraddha Mahalle Consultant Dermatologist and Cosmetologist Director Skinshine Clinic practicing at Laxmi Nagar Nagpur, This was followed by a short talk by Mr. Gopal Dave putting more emphasis on early to bed routine and healthy food intake.

Followed by free check up camp on the same day and continued on Monday and it was attended by Principal, Dr. Pooja Pathak, Vice Principal, Dr. Rujuta Bapat, Head of Cosmetic Department Dr. Deepak Wasule accompanied with Dr. Sangeeta Saharabuddhe, the contributory teachers of Cosmetic Technology and the students of different department, like BID, Electronics, HMCT and Home Science including their respective teachers. The entire seminar was arranged and organized by B. Tech. 3<sup>rd</sup> year students of Cosmetic Technology under the supervision of Prof. Saharabuddhe.

Dr. Shraddha Mahalle has presented her presentation in 5 parts, the 1<sup>st</sup> part covers basics about skin layers and types of skins which included epidermis, dermis, and subcutaneous layer along with that she had explained very theoretically what happens in each layer of our skin, and explained in detail about the dry skin, oily skin, combination skin, sensitive skin, in the 2<sup>nd</sup> part of her presentation she explained in detail about the major roles/functions performed by the skin and how we have to take care of our skin which included protection, defense mechanism, vitamin D production, temperature regulation, prevent moisture loss, sensory organ and many more along with how skin is the largest organ of the body and how we have to take care of our skin and help it to perform it's function properly . In the 3<sup>rd</sup> part of her presentation she explained very thoroughly what all were the skin problems that humans go through starting it from ulcers, acne, comedons, pigmentation, melasma, freckles, warts, PCOD, hair fall, nail chipping and Dr. Mahalle also explained what all were the reasons behind these skin problems, she focused on vitamin deficiency, poor diet, poor nutritional intake and many more, further she added what she does to help people by providing her services through counseling patients to providing cosmetic procedures which include cosmetic peeling, micro needling of HA, hydration therapy, laser therapy for pigmentation and permanent hair removal etc. she also added which type of sunscreens and what type of creams should be used on our skin, she emphasized on how steroid containing creams are famous among common people and how they used it unknowingly and damage their skin unintentionally. She explained and recommended not to use steroid containing creams on any part of the body. She warned to check the ingredients list first before buying, after this she explained what signs does over skin give when there is certain deficiency in our body started with vitamin A & D deficiency which included patch in cornea, night blindness, dry skin, dry eyes, poor wound healing etc. Last but not the least she advised all the students to maintain proper



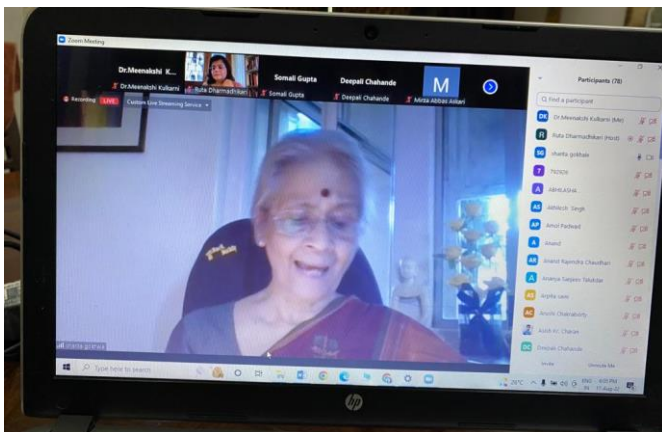
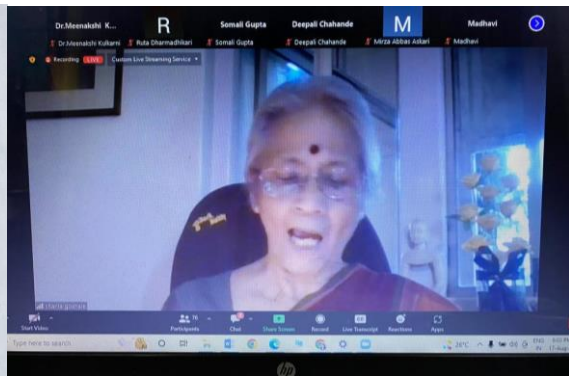
diet which include protein, vitamins, carbohydrate, minerals, fats etc. and avoid any kind of junk food instead include milk, paneer, soya in your daily diet along with green leafy vegetables to avoid PCOD, hair fall to have good mirror like glowing skin. In order to achieve that she advised to exercise regularly, stay hydrated, and eat healthy.

Overall it was very informative and interactive session followed by Questions & Answers at last. All had a great time and had surely learnt more about the inner body along with external application.

## In a noisy world, Gokhale explains virtue of silence



**Nagpur:** Silence is something more than mere absence of noise. It can also be a presence of peace, clarity and tranquillity, said Shanta Gokhale, Sahitya Akademi Award winner, writer, translator, theatre and culture critic on Wednesday.

Gokhale was delivering the second Dr Kamala Narayanan memorial lecture on "Can we have some silence, please?" in memory of the former head, department of English and former vice-principal, LAD College and Smt RP College for women. The lecture was organized by the department of English of the college on an online platform.

The lecture on Kamala Narayanan, who was a highly respected teacher, able administrator and enthusiastic

academician, was streamed live on YouTube.

Gokhale, a writer and translator since 1960, spoke about the importance of silence in art, its cultural significance, value as a personal and social practice and its connection with spirituality.

**ART ANGLE**

An author of two novels, a few plays, short stories, film scripts and innumerable newspaper articles, Gokhale said today there are noises everywhere, even in hospitals, and we are living in a marketplace filled with noises.

She had been a culture columnist with The Independent, The Sunday Times of India, Mid-Day, and Mumbai Mirror. She has also written essays, short fiction and autobiographies. She has translated plays by Vijay Tendulkar, Mahesh Elkunchwar, Satish

Alekar, GP Deshpande and Rajeev Naik from Marathi into English. She has also translated Gieve Patel's play 'Mr Behram' and Jerry Pinto's novel 'Em and the Big Hoom' from English into Marathi.

The writer said that in today's world, character has been replaced by personality. Citing example of her experience with management students, she said audibility matters in today's age of cut-throat competition and silence is considered as self-destructive. "An introvert is considered a loser while the one showing off is viewed as a winner," she said.

Poets, writers, students and teachers from all disciplines attended the lecture. Later, the participants interacted with Gokhale and asked a few questions. The programme was concluded by a vote of thanks.
