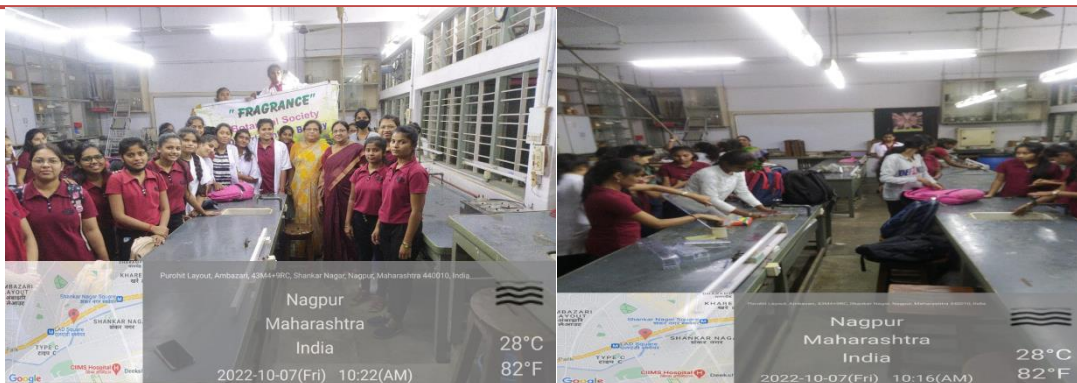
Shramdaan organized by Science faculty staff and students on 07 October 2022:

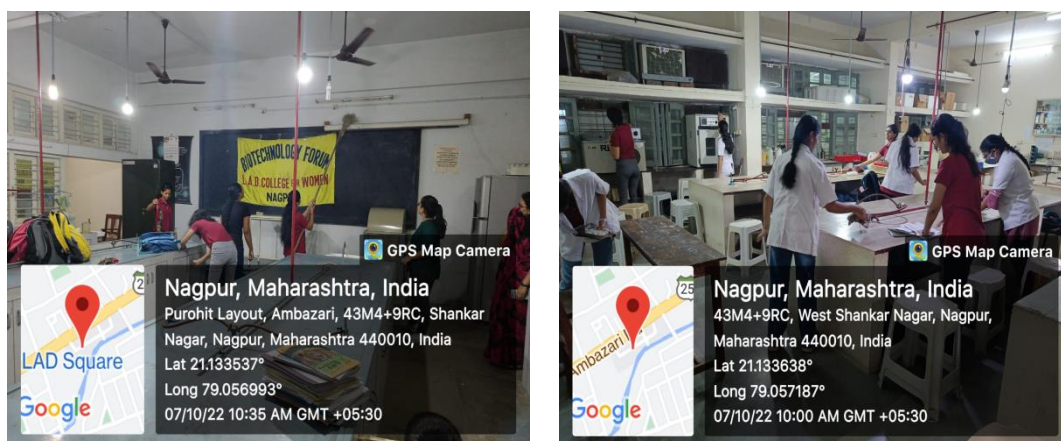
