ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2016

I) An Overview

It has been an eventful year to say the least culminating in NAAC reaccreditation in the third cycle validating our "A" Grade. But our cause for satisfaction lies in the fact that we were identified as a College with Potential for Excellence by the UGC from 2016 onwards for the next five years. Also we have been recognized as Centres of Research in 11 departments taking the total to 12. Our college has been identified under Rashtriya Avishkar Abhiyan by the Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University as mentor college for creating awareness in science in schools.

Besides a number of activities in collaboration with NSS of RTMNU and Mohan Foundation Organ donation, Hiroshima Day where we lived the horror of 6th August 1945, with actual video recordings from the India Peace Centre through its Director Kasta Dip. Interactive sessions with American Libraries, American Embassy Mumbai, Two LAD Roundtable – on Film Appreciation by Gayatri Chatterjee, of Symbiosis School of Liberal Arts, Pune and in collaboration with Cine Montage and another on Nutrition and Neutraceutical Supplements was organized in collaboration with the Nutrition Society of India, Dr Sabiha Vali a Senior academician and scholar was the resource person. A Panel Discussion on waste management with green vigil, and Kirloskar Vasundhara Film Festival was organized. Students of BID participated in the wall graffiti project of beautification organized by the Nagpur Muncipal Corporation, NSS students participated in a Tiger project street play, collaboration with the South Central Cultural Zone, VED and MTDC for the Maharashtra festival in December. Besides Yoga Day, the Breast Feeding Awareness, All this, along with the regular cultural fest and competitions, the food festival, this time with Mexico as food theme, the cake fair and academic activities, the Women's Studies & Research Centre

have continued to be benchmarks of LAD. The Dept of Music in collaboration with the Vidarbha Sahitya Sangh organized a programme 'Swarprahbha'. Being a multifaculty college with diverse interests these imprints are only indicative not exhaustive.

As payback to the almamater the LAD Alumnae Association has to be commended for having come together and brought out an Alumnae directory. Besides the sponsorsip of the bi-annual LAD Research Journal every year, we are grateful for the sponsorship of two wheel chairs by the association. The Department of Cosmetic Technology held a Mega Alumnae Meet where our alumnae have climbed the corporate ladder and made their mark as leaders in the Cosmetic Industry. It was heartening to note that an amount of one lakh as impressed fund was handed over to deserving students by Mr. Krishnan in memory of his wife Mrs Pal who was an alumnae of the department. Also the department of Cosmetic Technology received an amount of 15 lakhs for upgradation of labs as a CSR initiative of Lotus Herbals Delhi. During the NAAC Alumnae meet was a proud moment for LAD.

At the National level all five of our faculty who participated in the IIT Bombay, ICT training in collaboration with SAP Germany held at VNIT have been given certificates of excellence. Four of them, and I am proud to mention here, from the Faculty of Arts received the SAP excellence Award of Rs5000/ each with an opportunity to become trainers themselves if they so desire.

Most PG Departments have created an active basal network for academic as well as industrial synergy. 24 of our faculty presented papers at International conferences. Four of our faculty have been awarded Ph.D. this year now 67 percent of our faculty are Doctorates. 25 of our faculty are in the Board of Studies task force.

The Tata Consultancy Services continues its CSR activity with training in Banking Finance and Communication. We are partners with WIPRO and have a number of MNCs placing our students in the mainstream and Niche segments of the corporate world. This year we have also strengthened our Entrepreneurship development Cell through a tie up with Maharashtra Centre for Entrepreneurship

Development, MSSC, MSME. We have tied up with Global TiE Women Entrepreneurs for Entrepreneurship opportunities and start ups. Besides Hilton, Marriott, Godrej Interio has also picked up our promising students.

The college was invited by SCZZC Nagpur to display their talent at a Cultural Test organized by them. Our student Bhakti Ghatole a visually challenged topper in the 11th continues to clinch top awards at the University. Also at the University level our student, Swaima Ahmed won the Vishnupant Jakatdar Elocution Competition and the Best Student award of the University. Four of our students have been chosen to represent the University for Avishkar.

Although we have separate day designated for prizes in sports, we cannot ignore our National and International winners in Badminton, Vaishnavi Bhale and coached at the Gopichand Akademi, Chess Shweta Gole and in Table Tennis and who have gone on to represent the university. Besides our students have won silver in gymnastics, kick boxing and Wusho. We also have a commendable presence as a women's cricket team with no contenders. Our enrolment for NCC is now of 100 cadets. Anushka Kulkarni was selected for Youth Exchange Programme 2016 at Vietnam Delegation in October 2016.ChhakuliThakre selected for Nehru Institute of Mountaineering Camp at Uttarkashi in May/June. 11 Cadets selected for Thal Sainik Camp at Pune and Poonam Sao wins Gold Medal in Running at Leadership Camp at Kolhapur in November.

Our college won the Best NSS College of the RTM Nagpur University again this year and Dr. Madhuri Datalkar was felicitated as best Programme Co-ordinator. Two of our students have also been felicitated at different events. The College Magazine Urmi won the Second Prize in the University Competition.

The cluster of colleges the Indradhanu has significantly contributed to a kind of synergy among the 11 colleges of the cluster with student ambassadors doing their bit, this year we filled up the National Institutional Ranking Framework of the MHRD. We are awaiting the results.

We were catapulted on a fast track on a digital highway, not only in terms of educational resources but in terms of administrative functions. A good proportion of most of the office records have been digitized. Added to this the process of online digital processes continues in admissions, examinations, financial transactions and routine matters. So also the library, we have improved upon reading spaces identified and disseminated digital resources and identified a section of rare books and manuscripts. We also received around eight hundred books from the late Mrs Amrut Chatterjee and another 700 in English and Philosophy and another 500 and odd books from Dr. Vidya Khare both of which we acknowledge gratefully as generous gifts towards enrichment of our library.

In keeping with the times the collaboration with ISRO continues for workshops on asset management and biodiversity. Hopefully in the next session we would see a cell for continuing education. One step towards it has already been started with the Digital Resource Centres of several Departments.

A confirmed list of 15 meritorious students hailing from different faculties who have featured in the Rashtrasant Tukdoji Maharaj Nagpur University keeping the tradition of the College alive. In addition we have around 142 endowment prizes claimed by those worthy enough to receive them. The numbers are encouraging and we believe that this will persuade them to conquer greater heights of excellence and knowledge. We will also take this opportunity to invite those who have passed out to form a viable alumnae base and keep in touch.

The college has honoured 22 teaching and non teaching staff who have completed 25 years of their service in this institution. Honourable Regional Director Dr. Shivswaroop did the honours of felicitating them. The sudden decision of the government to revoke the age of superannuation to 60 years has created a vacuum of senior teachers. However many of them have volunteered to be available and contribute in whatever way possible to tide over the staff crunch. This pay back initiative of the teaching staff is more than acknowledged.

Each year as we report the events we acknowledge deeply the support and vision of a proactive management of W.E.S., Adv. V.R.Manohar, President; Justice M.S.Deshpande (Retd.) & Shri Hargovind Bajaj, Vice Presidents; Dr. Panna Akhani, Hon. Director/Secretary; Smt. Time - Table Committee (Science Faculty):

• The Time-Table for the session 2016 – 17 was prepared by the committee members, Mrs. Radhika Yelkawar and Dr. Mrs. Charita Patil. It was circulated to all the departments and also displayed on the notice boards. It was implemented from 1 July 2016.

Attendance Committee (Science Faculty):

• Proforma for monthly attendance is circulated to all the departments. The attendance of students is entered for each subject. The total of annual attendance of all subjects is calculated. The fine is calculated for absentees and the list is submitted to the office. The students whose attendance is below 50 % are given warning and asked to make up their attendance. Parents of such students are also informed.

Examination Committee (Science Faculty):

• Internal Assessment Examination of B.Sc. - I, II & III were sincerely conducted by all the Science Departments.

Mentorship Committee (Science Faculty):

• For academic year 2016-17, the first meeting was taken on 6 September 2016 to allot mentors to respective batches of Science faculty. Also the reports and mentorship forms of last year was collected.

Students Feedback Committee (Science Faculty):

• Feedback forms were distributed to all students of B.Sc. Sem-VI in the last week of February 2016. Different parameters are calculated from feedback forms filled by students.

Stock verification:

- The verification of the stock of different departments was carried out as per the given schedule in the month of April 2016. The Stock Verification of all the Science Departments were done after the reopening of the college in the month of June because of the semester pattern.

Parent Teacher Association (Shankar Nagar Campus):

- The first meeting of the Parent Teacher Association for the session 2016-2017 was held on 27August.2016 in the Niyogi Hall premises in Shankar Nagar campus for Science, Arts, Commerce and Home Science Faculties. This meeting was for induction of parents of First year students as members and also to apprise the members about the forthcoming NAAC Peer Team Visit in the month of September. Around one hundred parents of students across all years attended the meeting.
- Dr. Kakoli Upadhyay, Convener, PTA, Science Faculty, gave an introduction about the facilities in the college and then about NAAC via a power-point presentation. This was followed by an interaction with the parents. The parents discussed freely with the Principal and teachers about attendance, sports scholarships and facilities, library facilities, placement opportunities and also lauded the efforts of the college in grooming their wards for good performance in examinations and also for shaping their personalities for a strong future.

• Dr. Shyamala Nair, Principal, addressed the parents and told the parents how through the PTA the parents can help in the healthy development of the institution. In all 115 students were selected by the committee as eligible for receiving the aid. This amount was distributed in the months of March & April 2016.

• The first program of the session conducted by the SQAC cell was the **Induction of First Year students** on 27 July 2016. The students were introduced to the different Facilities provided by the college, the Conveners of the Student-related Cells and were also given a briefing on the History of the college by a power-point presentation. Later, Dr. Shyamala Nair, Principal, addressed the students and told them about importance of attendance and proper behaviour and mannerisms the students should adopt while studying in this college.

- As the second program of the session, the Students' Quality Assurance Cell along with the Indradhanu cluster of colleges organized the **Investiture ceremony** of Student Ambassadors of eleven colleges on 6 August, 2016. Two student ambassadors each from the two campuses of the college were selected by SQAC to represent the college in Indradhanu.
- The Students' Quality Assurance Cell of the college arranged on 11August 2016 at 12:00 noon an 'Interface-2016' of students and teachers in the Niyogi Hall premises, Shankar Nagar campus. The students and teachers of both the campuses were present. Principal Dr. Shyamala Nair was on the chair along with Vice-Principals Dr. Bhanumati Malewar & Harsha Jharia . Conveners of SQAC, Dr. Kakoli Upadhyay & Ruta Dharmadhikari had arranged this program as a preparation for 'Students' Meet' during the forthcoming NAAC Peer Team Visit. A power-point presentation was made about the college to enable the students of both the campuses become familiar with the facilities available in both the campuses and also about NAAC. An interaction followed where students discussed freely about their achievements, expectations from the college and also gave suggestions for better functioning of the college. The teachers also told the students about what they ought to be aware of, especially the attendance, the dates for assignments, and also about the mentor scheme adopted by the college. The NAAC co-ordinator Dr. Bhanumati Malewar addressed the students about the nature of Students' Meet and that all of them should attend in spite of Ganesh Festival during the NAAC visit period.

Cleanliness Committee (Shankar Nagar Campus):

- Meeting of the cleanliness committee was held on 27 January 2016, which was attended by all the members. Various issues were discussed regarding cleanliness of the campus.
- A meeting was held on 15 July 2016 with members of the committee. A list of problems faced regarding ensuring a clean campus and possible solutions was submitted.
- A meeting was also held with Principal and Vice- Principals regarding cleanliness of the campus before NAAC visit and various issues such as disposal of garbage, dog menace, cleanliness of washrooms were discussed.
- A thorough inspection of the college premises was done before the visit of the NAAC peer team and a list of requirements was submitted to the Vice Principal.
- Combined efforts of Committee members, supervisor and sweepers have resulted in maintaining cleanliness of the college campus.

Canteen Committee:

The meeting of canteen committee was held on 27 April 2016. The committee has initiated and implemented the following measures:

- Video camera in the staff compartment of canteen was installed in the month of the February 2016.
- The door which opens towards the toilet was permanently closed. Curtains were put up in the windows.
- In July 2016, day wise edibles/ dishes chart was made and action was taken to follow it. Thirty chairs were added to the existing facilities.
- Beautification of canteen premises was done with plantation and rock- garden beds outside canteen area.
- Telephone extension operation unit was replaced.
- Adjacent portion of canteen in front of students' toilet was closed by extending wall of the canteen by <u>profile sheets</u>. This arrangement has made the toilet and canteen as <u>two separate blocks</u>.
- Hygienic quality of drinking water supply of canteen was tested monthly during the period January 2016 to December 2016 by Department of Microbiology. Canteen staff for medical fitness was examined and certified by Dr. Bethariya, MBBS. DPH, Bombay.
- Agreement was made on 1 June 2016 with Mrs. Indu Gulati, Canteen In-charge and Dr. Shyamala Nair, Principal, that junk food should not be served to students.

Indradhanu (Cluster of colleges):

- A meeting of the Conveners of the **'Indradhanu'** Cluster of Colleges was held on 26 April, 2016 at L. A. D and Smt. R. P. College for Women, Nagpur, at 3.00 PM to review the activities of 2015-16 and to chalk out programs for 2016-17.
- The Indradhanu Cluster of Colleges organized **Tree Plantation Drive** jointly with the NSS units of both campuses of our college on 5 July, 2016 at the Seminary Hills campus of our college. Five Colleges of the Cluster participated.
- The annual **Investiture Ceremony** of Student Ambassadors was held on 6 August. The program was joint activity of the Indradhanu and SQAC. Mr. Kasta Dip, Director, India Peace Center, Nagpur, was the Guest- of- honour and Dr. Shyamala Nair, Principal, administered the pledge. Nine colleges of the cluster participated.
- **Guest Lecture** on the occassion of **Hiroshima Day** was organized on 6 August, 2016, jointly with Human Rights Cell of our College. Mr. Kasta Dip, Director, India Peace Center, Nagpur, delivered a lecture on 'Towards a Nuclear Free World and Peace'. Nine colleges of the cluster participated.

Faculty of Commerce Admission Committee Report

- The committee started its admission work from June 1, 2016. The admission to B. Com. I were made on first come basis and as per the instructions and guidelines issued by the administration.
- Junior college students of L.A.D. & Smt. R. P. College who have passed their XII std. examination in first attempt were considered on priority basis for admission to B. Com. I whereas for external students cut off percentage was 60% in English medium.
- In all 328 students (215 English medium + 113 Marathi medium) were admitted to B. Com. I in the academic session 2016-2017.
- The admission process continued till July 30, 2016.

Attendance Committee

- Attendance registers were distributed to the faculty members in the 1st week of July 2016 as per their requirements. They were also requested to maintain proper record of student's attendance.
- The students pursuing professional courses like CA, CS, ICWA, MBA etc. were advised to submit applications in the prescribed format along with proof to the convener so that they may be given exemption in attendance. Apart from these, other exemption applications were to be routed through the convener and then handed over to attendance committee for further record keeping.
- As per the instructions and guidelines issued by the Principal-Dr. Nair and Head of Commerce Faculty, Miss V. Karkare, 1st List indicating class and medium wise attendance percentage of students was displayed on Students Notice Board in the 2st week of

October, 2016. This attendance percentage was computed on the basis of data provided by respective subject teachers for a period of June 16th to October 15th, 2016.

- It was done to create awareness among the students regarding their short attendance and also to provide an opportunity to improve it by attending classes regularly in the subsequent months.
- An understanding was given to such habitual absentees that if they fail to collect the warning letters and justify their absence they would be detained from University Examination.
- A final list of habitual absentees having attendance below 50% will be prepared in the last week of February 2017 with the completion of syllabus for all the subjects and classes.
- Fine will be imposed on such absentees for their short attendance as per the guidelines of Principal and Head, of the Faculty of Commerce. Fine list will be submitted to the office in the first week of March 2017 for further action.

Time Table Committee

- The college reopened after summer vacation on 16 June 2016. A tentative time table for B. Com. II and B. Com. III was displayed on 16 June 2016 and was applicable from the very next day i.e. 17 June 2016.
- B. Com. I Classes started from 1 July 2016. Hence a full fledged final time table was prepared and implemented from 1 July 2016 for all the three years B. Com. I, II and III, English and Marathi Medium. Necessary changes were made in the time table afterwards, with the joining of newly appointed teachers and to suit the requirements of faculty from time to time.
- The committee members informed every faculty member to follow the final timetable.

University Grants Commission, New Delhi

The proposal of the college for financial assistance of Rs.1 Crore 50 lakhs under the scheme **'College with Potential for Excellence'** (CPE) during XII plan (2012-2017) was submitted by the college vide letter no. Gen/2015-16/1531 on 23rd January, 2016 to U.G.C. New Delhi and the same was forwarded by the Director, B.C.U.D. Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University, Nagpur vide their letter No. BCUD/P/2016/88 dated 25-1-2016. U.G.C. New Delhi vide letter No. F-12-1/2010/2015(NS/PE) dated 27th May, 2016 approved the college with Potential for Excellence' (CPE) Status during XII plan period under the CPE scheme for a period of 5 years from 1st April 2016 to 31st March 2021 subject to submission of few certificates and undertakings from the college.

U.G.C. New Delhi on 2nd August, 2016 displayed in their website the list of identified 123 CPE Colleges under CPE scheme during XII plan period identifying the L. A.D. College at Sr. No. 78 as College with Potential for Excellence.

On submission of necessary certificates and undertakings to U.G.C. New Delhi college received a letter No.F. No.10-78/2016(NS/PE) dated 4-10-2016 informing the college that U.G.C. in its meeting held on 2-9-2016 decided that colleges would be considered for grant CPE status subject to submission of undertaking in an affidavit on stamp paper that the funds provided under the scheme would not be used for the Junior college i.e. 10+2 classes. The first installment of grant would be released only after submission of the required affidavit.

On 26-12-2016 college submitted the undertaking on stamp paper stating the grant of CPE would not be used for Junior College, alongwith other relevant document. The matter is under process.
