#### **ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2019**

# I) An Overview

It is a great pleasure to present before the members of the Women's Education Society, the Annual Report for the year 2019-2020 of this 87 years old College born out of a philanthropic motive to Empower Women with access to Higher Education.

For the year 2019-2020 college was recognized as the Best Sports Performer among City Colleges with a token of appreciation and a cash prize of Rs 3000/- towards GH Raisoni –SJAN Achievers Award. College Principal was also invited to receive the KC Bajaj Trophy for promoting Sports culture during the 22<sup>nd</sup> edition of the SJAN-GH Raisoni Achievers Award organized by the Sports Journalist Association of Nagpur on 29<sup>th</sup> December 2019.

First installment of non-recurring grant of Rs. 14,40,000/-for SC (16%) has been credited into the college account on 7-12-2019-under the Scheme of College with Potential for Excellence, this shall also be utilized within the sanctioned budget range. **AG Audit of accounts** and other relevant record from the year **2010-2011 to 2018-2019** was conducted by the office of Auditor General (Audit-II Maharashtra) Nagpur from 9<sup>th</sup> Sept to 26<sup>th</sup> September 2019.

Process for request of **continuation of affiliation** of permanently non grant courses from the session 2020-21 and onwards was started in the month of August 2019. Local Enquiry Committee visited the college for **Continuation of Affiliation** for all self-financed courses of the college on 27<sup>th</sup> December 2019.

RUSA (Rashtriya Ucchatar Shikshan Abhiyan) file, NIRF (National Institutional Ranking Framework) Data, AQAR 2018-19 as per new guidelines to NAAC and AISHE (All India Survey of Higher Education) data has been successfully submitted. College has also registered in the "Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA)" to join flagship program of the MHRD to make fruitful contribution for the rural development of India and is mandatory for institutions with at least 2000 students and in SHREYAS (Scheme for Higher Education Youth in Apprenticeship and Skills) a paid apprenticeship scheme that has been started for student passing out of Non-Technical Higher Educational Institutions and has chosen the sector Health- Care and sub sector Patient Relations Associate.

"PAT ON THE BACK" was organized on 22<sup>nd</sup> March, 2019 on Founders day. Dr. Uma Vaidya, Council member was the Chief Guest of the day. 17 students and 3 staff members were felicitated. Student Induction Program (SIP) was held for 4 days in both the campuses based on the suggestions during the SIP workshop held in Pune which was attended by Dr. Ruta Dharmadhikari SQAC coordinator. The Student Ambassadors of 'Indradhanu' –Cluster of Colleges were installed in a grand investiture ceremony at the hands of Dr. Pramila Shastri, Former HOD, Food Technology, L.I.T, Nagpur and the students were administered pledge.

The **National level conference** on New Guidelines for Assessment and Accreditation was organized on 21<sup>st</sup> Sept 2019 in the college with academic collaboration without financial assistance from NAAC. The conference gave an insight regarding the new procedure to be followed from the experts from various places and especially due to the elaborate speech of Dr. Devendar Kawade from NAAC and the auspicious presence of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor- Dr. S. Kane.

The college staff, students and N.S.S. Units (I& II) celebrated the joy of giving (*Daan*) in the first week of October, 2019. Selfless service to the society inclusive of college, hostels, anganwadis, schools, old age homes and adopted villages - was the main focus. Distribution of utility items, donations, Edu-*Daan*, *Shram-Daan*, etc. were undertaken. "Volunteer Writers List" published by the student ambassadors of Indhradhnu was a path – breaking sensitive attempt - this year as well. On the concluding day, members from SnehanchalVednaUpshaman Kendra (Palliative care) and Sandhya SawardhanSanstha were invited, in the august presence of

Jt. Secretary Varsha Manohar. The **Daan Utsav 2019** has left a lasting impression in all those who got involved, with a promise and a zeal to do more selfless service to the society.

Since last year, a focused involvement and commitment has been observed by the entire staff and students of the college around one theme as a distinctive feature of the college. To create awareness among students about various social issues related to their life have triggered the concept of extension and various socio academic activities linked with health by way of announcing 2019-20 as Health Literacy Year which was formally inaugurated on the International Yoga Day. Many socio-academic activities-Beauty and Health contest, Personality Development, Slogan, Poster, Quiz, Debate competitions and Health Awareness Surveys were held. Symposium on Essentials of Nutrition in Sports Performance was held in association with Nutrition Society of India Nagpur Chapter. Three distinguished Scientists from National Institute of Nutrition-NIN- Hyderabad gave a focused presentation and lectures on three themes. National level Seminar on Aarogyam Dhansampada – A Lifelong Treasure was organized on 14<sup>th</sup> December 2019. Well known Dignitaries and Luminaries and experts from Nagpur, Mumbai, Pune, Bangaluru were invited. The Inaugural programme was presided by Dr. Avinash Deshmukh, Vice President of Women's Education Society and had Professor of Excellence, Prof. of Eminence and Prof. Emeritus, Honorable Chancellor of Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences, Karad, Dr. Vedprakash Mishra as the Chief Guest.

The senior and the Junior College staff members organized the annual **Prize Distribution** and the Cultural Programs with great zeal and enthusiasm so as to boost the academic and the cultural events with accolade keeping the tradition of the college alive students from different faculties have won endowment prizes;

The college publishes a biannual peer reviewed **Research Journal** with a duly authorized ISSN. Two volumes are in process of publication. The **Swaprakashan Publication Cell** of the college is dedicated to encourage all college publications under one casing since 2006-the year of its establishment. Out of the 110 ISBN Blocks that it had received from RajaramMohun Roy National Agency for ISBN, Government of India, Ministry of Human Resource Development, Department of Higher Education, New Delhi, more than **30** 

**Books with the Swaprakashan ISBN** have been published. During the year 2019 the publication cell published college Prospectus 2019-20, College Annual Magazine Urmi 2019 and Research Journals. Few Laboratory Manuals based on the syllabus have been published which are being used by the other colleges under RTMNU, Nagpur on a regular basis since its inception. This year too Conference Proceedings of the National Conference on New Guidelines for Assessment and Accreditation is published and the proceedings on National Seminar on Aarogyam Dhanasampada- A Lifelong Treasure shall be published under Swaprakashan Banner.

The Department of HMCT got a funding of 13 lakhs under the scheme of MODROB (Modernization and Removal of Obsolescence Scheme). Department under the Ministry of Tourism, Government of India has also conducted the programme Hunnar Se RojgarTak., other programmes like Food Production Multi Cuisine Cook, Food and Beverage Service-Steward programmes for Supervisors and Laboratory were held. The students underwent Hospitality Operations Training Programme for the Hearing Impaired. The training was jointly organized by Sir Gangadharrao Chitnavis Memorial Medical Research Trust in collaboration with SAKSHAM Disability Employment Information Centre and L.A.D College. Cake fair and the Food Festival – Western Tadka were the routine events undertaken.

Faculty of Commerce and Management conducted seminars on Interview Skills Financial Market Awareness cum Career Guidance' 'Corporate Expectations' 'New Trends in IT Companies' and also '21st Century's Career Opportunity' for students. The Human Right Cell conducted 6 weeks Certificate course on "Water Conservation Right to Safe and Clean Water" and 12 week Diploma course in "Water Conservation and Water Audit Techniques" which was approved by Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University's Department of Life Long Learning and Extension, under "Jeevan Shikshan Abhiyan". Also the department of Interior Design has conducted a Six Weeks Certificate Course on "Exploring Sustainability in Indian Context" under Jeevan Shikshan Abhiyan of Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension, RTMNU. Round Table Conferences were held in the Departments of HMCT and PG Fashion Design. The Department of Biochemistry conducted a one month certificate course in Laboratory Training titled 'Blood Bank Orientation Programme' in collaboration with Dr. Hedgewar Blood Bank, Shivaji Nagar, Nagpur. Staff of Physical

Education and Sports organized **Girls Cricket Tournament** under the banner of "Catalyst" Fitness Club at Abhyankar Nagar Cricket Ground. The tournament was inaugurated by **Dr. Avinash Deshmukh**, **Vice President**, **W.E.S** and **Shri Sameer Sahasrabuddhe and Shri Goverdhan from Hyderabad** were prominently present. **Summer Cricket Coaching Camp** was also conducted in which 20 college students participated.

On 11<sup>th</sup> September 2019 a MOU has been signed between the Women's Educations Society's L.A.D. & Smt. R.P. College for Women for Department of Cosmetic Technology, Nagpur and Mr. Sudhir Prasad Rai, New Delhi for a period of one year to formulate and develop the products- Men Cosmetics Hair Pomade and all-purpose cosmetic oil as a product development activity in the Cosmetic Technology Departmental Laboratories intended for educational and research purposes.

Various **Skill Education (SkEd)** Training, Workshops and Certificate courses in collaboration with experts, institutions and industry have been undertaken by the college throughout the year. Educational, Soft Skills, Hard Skills and Life Skills Development activities by renowned trainers and experts under the aegis of Skill Education were held. For this year under **SkEd** the Scholarship Committee has started the 3 months Help Desk Course in "**Digitalization of Application for Govt. Scholarship**" for our students. Four Skill Education Programs were conducted for students to gain in-depth knowledge about latest trends in electronics and computer software field and also to give hands on training in latest technologies. 45 students participated in One week 'Computer Literacy Program' in collaboration with Sigma Computers Nagpur, 40 students participated in "Broad Band Technician" course under Pandit Deendayal Upadhyay Upakram of BSNL. Faculty of Commerce and Management conducted a week long Skill- Education (SkEd Level II) Certificate Course on Career Opportunities in Securities Market and Mutual Fund (COSMMF) from 5<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup>August 2019.

She has been

Few have been awarded PhD degree in their respective subjects.

Kala Bahaar 2019-2020- the annual cultural festival of Junior College was held in December while the second edition of AURA –Inter collegiate Cultural Fest—spanning for 5 days- was completely conceptualized by the students to showcase their performance skills, cognitive and creative skills as well as entrepreneurship and leadership skills. A Digital Notice Board was purchased from the funds raised under this activity and the same was inaugurated on the Founders Day. Students club Khoj- Historical Quest, Jabberworks-Literature Magazine, Scintilla, Busy-Bee, Kruti, etc were many Department based activities/ publications which has promoted expansive thinking, innovative ideas and creativity. Yoga Day, Home Science Exhibition- Skill Villa, Garba, Cake fair, Miss L.A.D, Spandan Wall Magazine and many such yearly events have continued to be the benchmarks of L.A.D- all organized in a very dignified, auspicious & elegant manner.
