ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2020

I) AN OVERVIEW

It is a great pleasure to present before the members of the Women's Education Society, the Annual Report for the year 2020-2021 of this 88 years old College born out of a philanthropic motive to empower women with access to higher education.

Maintaining a step forward with positivity – our staff has conducted online classes and examinations, even during this pandemic period. This adverse condition has not deterred us from doing our activities as far as teaching, learning and training programs are concerned- this legacy of our college is being sincerely carried forward. The overall pass percentage of H.S.S.C. 2020 was 92.58%. Vaibhavi Kohale secured 94.15% and was the City's First Topper in Arts Stream followed by Shreya Dave (second city topper) and Anushree Wakhare (third city topper). City's third topper, Kamakhya Nadge in Commerce stream secured 95.69%. Dilpreet Kaur Sokhi from the senior college – science stream - was awarded as the Best Student by the Rashtrasant Tukadoji Maharaj Nagpur University on 4th August 2020. NSS Unit I Volunteer, Kavita Raj Maru bagged the NSS Best Volunteer Award at University Level in 2020 for the year 2019-2020. Dr. Meenakshi Kulkarni, Programme Officer, NSS Unit II received the NSS Best Programme Officer Award at University Level in 2020 for the year 2019-2020. In the month of February 2020, College Principal has received honour of recognition by Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Association of Engineers for motivating the Junior College Students to participate in the State level "Vaicharic Prashnnotari spardha."

On 29th January 2020, inspection of the **Department of Electronics**, **Junior College** was held. **Shaala Siddhi**, online details about the junior college was submitted successfully on 18th February 2020. The online details about **Shalarth Profile** has been successfully uploaded on 24th December 2020.

Joint Secretary, University Grants Commission, New Delhi, vide letter No. F.10-78/2016 (NS/PE) dated 3rd March 2017 conferred the status of CPE- College With Potential For Excellence – for a period of Five years from 1st April 2016 to 31st March 2021 with the budget of Rs. 90 Lakhs in Capital Assets -35 (Non-Recurring) and Rs. 60 Lakhs (@ Rs. 12 Lakhs per year) in Grant–in-aid General -31 (Recurring). College has received the Non-Recurring amount of Rs. 82,80,000/- out of sanctioned Ninety Lakhs and the Recurring amount of Rs. 12,00,000/- out of sanctioned Sixty Lakhs till December 2020. Utilization of the same as per allocations under budget head is complete.College is yet to receive 1st Installment Non-Recurring grant of Rs. 7, 20,000/- for ST (8%) and Recurring grant of Rs. 12 Lakhs per year for remaining 4 years (Rs. 48 Lakhs).

Local Enquiry Committee (LEC) for continuation of affiliation visit was held in the last week of December 2019 and all the self-financed courses now continue to remain connected with the University for the next three more years. The College was allotted Guidance Centre for Online XI Std. Centralized Admission Process for West and South West Region of Nagpur for the academic session 2020 – 2021 by the Deputy Director of Education, Nagpur.

As a distinctive feature of the college, since last two years, a theme is announced and the entire college organises various programs revolving around the topic. Academic year 2020-21 is declared with a very apt theme - "Mindfulness Literacy Year"; under this themed year, the team has organized various online webinars and competitions. The inaugural function started with a webinar on "Emotional Wellness in Challenging Times" by Ms. Sagarika Mishra, acounselling psychologist and life coach. Feedback for the session was informative, educative and

excellent. 93 participants both from the Junior and Senior College attended this webinar. On 29 June 2020 "Embodying stillness: Finding Peace of Mind amidst Covid-19". The resource person Mrs. Rajita Kulkarni- President Sri Sri University, Bhubaneshwar gave a detailed comprehensive concept of meditation. Vice President, W.E.S., Dr. Avinash Deshmukh also joined the webinar and graced the occasion. "A National Level Power Point Competition" in collaboration with the NSS Cell of Rashtrasant Tukdoji Maharaj Nagpur University, Nagpur was initiated by the College in the month of September 2020 under the aegis of Mindfulness Literacy Year in which Fifty three Participants This year also tabletop calendar of our college was prepared made from the selective posters of college students.

Peer Review –cum- inspection of the Department of BID was conducted by the Indian Institute of Interior Design comprising a team of eminent experts from the Interior Design and Architectural field, Mr. Rajeev Sathe, Education Member from Mumbai and Mrs. Aparna Bidarkar from Hyderabad on 5th March 2020. An exhibition was arranged displaying Students' understanding of the core subjects they are studying. Current Students and Alumni were given an opportunity to explain their subject works.

Department of Psychology created a **WhatsApp group SAMADHAN-Help Desk** for counselling and guiding the students during lockdown period on 10thApril 2020 as a part of the **Student Mentoring Activity**. Several students sought personal guidance on their psycho–socio difficulties, stress, tension, anxiety issues, etc. through telephonic conversations from their Psychology teachers. This help desk actively continues to counsel students in these critical times of COVID-19.

Daan Utsav 2020 was celebrated from 2nd to 8th October 2020 as the Joy of Giving. The main focus of this year's Utsav was Online Edu Daan and majority of the events were conducted on Google Meet Platform. Women's Study Centre organized a Webinar on DIGITAL STREE SHAKTI-to train young girls about cyber safety, in collaboration with Maharashtra State Women's Commission and Responsible Netism. This education in cyber space was a journey towards empowerment not only to reduce cyber threats but to equip to handle online distress and this has been conceptualized by Responsible Netism - a non-profit organisation in the state aiming to educate cyber safety ambassadors – which is the need of the

hour – as the usage of internet has increased many fold. An interactive Power Point Presentation was conducted by Mr. Gajanan Rajmane, Deputy Commissioner of Police, Crime Branch, Nagpur on Drug Awareness Campaign on 8th January 2020. Shri Chinmay Pandit, (IPS) Deputy Commissioner of Police, Traffic Police was the Chief Guest. Both the programes were organised by NSS Unit and also the special camps were successfully arranged.

The college publishes a biannual peer reviewed **Research Journal** with a duly authorized ISSN. Two volumes are in process of publication. The **Swaprakashan Publication Cell** of the college is dedicated to encourage all college publications under one casing since 2006-the year of its establishment. During the year 2020, the publication cell published college Prospectus 2020-21 and College Annual Magazine Urmi 2020. The **third edition** of the **Intercollegiate Cultural Festival, AURA 2020** was held from 30th January to 2nd February 2020. It witnessed an overwhelming participation from maximum colleges of RTMNU, Nagpur. This year four new competitions, viz., Storytelling, Charcoal Sketching, Diet Quiz and Village Sports were introduced. Online teaching has now become the order of the day and to follow the NEW Normal ways of ethics and guidelines -COVID 19 Cleanliness Committee, Online Examination Coordination Committee, Internal Marks Vigilance Committee and the Digital Mode Recommendation committee were formed within the college.

College had initiated various webinars during the critical times of COVID- 19 for the college staff- senior and junior. Online Faculty Development Programme on Flipped Classroom- An Effective Pedagogy was held on 13th April, 2020 in collaboration with Vellalar College for Women (Autonomous), Erode, Tamil Nadu wherein the entire teaching staff-Senior and Junior college had participated. A Two day Workshop on Training for Teaching on Virtual Platform, (G-suite Training- Google Meet, Google Forms, Classroom and Google Calendar) was organised for the College teaching staff, on 13th and 14thJuly 2020, followed by a One day Workshop on Training on Virtual Teaching for Technical Team was organised for selected staff members and conducted on 18th July 2020. A Workshop on How to Prepare Google Forms was organised on August 8th, and a Two Day Workshop on Training for Conducting Online Exam was held on 12th and 14th September 2020. On the first day, a detailed practice session was conducted on creating online question paper in Google forms, marking scheme, general and quiz settings etc. And the next

session was dedicated for the discussion on setting up of various extensions related to paper setting in other languages and practical subjects, handling online answer sheets and its tabulation. Doubts and queries of the teachers were also addressed during the practice session by **Dr. Shreeja Kurup**. A PDF file containing detailed steps of the contents of both days of workshop prepared by the resource person was also provided to the participants for further practice. There were total 89 participants on Day-1 and 65 participants on the second day. **Mr. Ajay Deoghare** from Office provided all the technical support for G- Suite training.

The College collaborated with Vellalar College for Women (Autonomous), Erode, Tamil Nadu and an Interstate Cluster of Colleges to organise a one week Faculty Development Programme titled Inclusive Quality Initiatives for Higher Education 27th April 2020 to 4th May 2020. Other Colleges who teamed up for this programme were DCT's Dhempe College of Arts and Science, Panaji, Goa, Kristu Jayanti College (Autonomous), Bengaluru, Karnataka, Smt. Radhadevi Goenka College for Women, Akola Maharashtra and St. Joseph's College for Women, Alappuzha, Kerala.)

The College arranged a Webinar on Dos and Don'ts of Research Paper Writing on 31st May 2020 Prof. Dr. Sanjay Sharma, Professor, JECRC University, Jaipur, a Fellow, Royal Society of Chemistry, UK and Green Chemistry Series Editor, Springer, UK was the resource person. The *Indradhanu*, Cluster of Colleges, Nagpur were also invited of which the College is the Lead College.

Energy Swaraj Foundation had invited the College as a Partner Organisation in the Learn to Design your Solar System by providing a unique opportunity to become Energy Literate. The course was organized as a part of the Energy Literacy Drive by the Energy Swaraj Foundation in association with the college. The recipients got a basic understanding of energy, power, electricity bills and solar systems. The recipients can estimate the electricity needs of a home. One hundred and Sixty nine students from various Departments of Shankar Nagar and Seminary Hills Campus registered for the Course which comprised of fifteen YouTube videos. Quiz was mandatory for obtaining the Certificate. The logo of the College has been placed on the Certificate of the sixty nine college students who have successfully completed the course. Principal Dr. Deepali

Kotwal coordinated and Ms. Kanchan Bade was appointed as the Convener of this course. The course was held in the first week of September 2020.

Various Skill Education (SkEd) Training, Workshops and certificate courses in collaboration with experts, institutions and industry have been undertaken by the college throughout the year. Department of Urdu organized 15 days (30 hours) Certificate Course in Urdu in collaboration with Justice M. L. Pendse School of languages and Media Studies from 3rd to 20th February 2020. Department of Geography organised small departmental projects by the students at the field visits at Village Hatla (Katol) and during the study visit to Regional Meteorological Centre, Nagpur. Department of Biotechnology organized a one month certificate course on *in vitro* plant culture from 10th February 2020 to 13th March 2020. 30 students of B.Sc. Semester II along with Final Year students of the Department of Biotechnology participated in this course. Dr. Krishnaveni Iyengar was the convener. The HMCT Department conducted a workshop on Cake Baking and Icing on 20th January 2020. Third and Fourth Year students successfully organized Cake Fair. The department successfully completed the second Hunnar Se Rojgaar Tak (HSRT) training programme in Food and Beverage Service. The department conducted Training program for Hearing impaired and the participants were placed in the various service sector, like Big Bazaar, Hotel Hermit etc. The Commerce Faculty organised a week-long skill-education (SkEd Level III) certificate course on Investment and Career Opportunities in Stock Market where Mr. Shailesh Sandel, Financial Advisor of Money Bee Institute Pvt. Ltd., Nagpur was the facilitator held from 2nd to 7th March 2020. A National Level mock Aptitude Test was conducted by NIIT, a training institute to prepare students for various competitive examinations for all the students of the commerce faculty of the college on 21st January 2020.

Aditi Patel (BID-Sem.-II) represented Vidarbha at the 5th Yuva Olympiad organized by Shri Akhil Bharatiya Kutch Kadva Patidar Yuvasangh from 4th to 6th January 2020 at Sabar Stadium, Himmatnagar, Gujarat where her Painting was placed 3rd and fetched Rs. 52,222/-. Namita Raut won first prize in State Level Kathak competition organized by Zilla Krida Adhikari held at Latur on 5th January 2020. Bharati

Yadav (B.A. Semester VI, HM) won 1st prize (Cash prize of Rs. 5000/-) in Hindi Sambhashan Pratiyogita organized jointly by PG department of Hindi, RTMNU and Bank of India on 10th January 2020 and received the Rising Superstar Award, in an International Online Speak to Win Contest organized by Quest Academy held from 12 to 19 July 2020. Ritika Bawangade XII AE won the Bhim Lekhani trophy for participating in the "Rajya Stariya Vaicharic Prashnnotari spardha" on 29th February 2020.

College with Potential for Excellence, CPE

Joint Secretary, University Grants Commission, New Delhi, vide letter No. F.10-78/2016 (NS/PE) dated 3rd March 2017 conferred the status of CPE- College With Potential For Excellence – for a period of Five years from 1st April 2016 to 31st March 2021 with the budget of Rs. 90 Lakhs in Capital Assets -35 (Non-Recurring) and Rs. 60 Lakhs (@ Rs. 12 Lakhs per year) in Grant—in-aid General -31(Recurring).

The 1st Installment grant of Rs.77,52,000/- (68,40,000/- Non- Recurring and 9,12,000/- Recurring) for General (76%) was transferred to the college account by UGC on 27.03.2018 through NEFT.

UGC on 02.01.2019 and 09.01.2019 transferred recurring grant of Rs. 1, 92,000/- for SC (16%) and Rs. 96,000/- for ST (8%) respectively.

Funds received till 31st March 2019 from the UGC were utilized as per allocations under budget head and the annual report (for the year 2016-17/2017-18 and 2018-19) has been sent to the UGC office and to both the Advisory Committee (CPE) members.

The 1st Installment Non- Recurring grant of Rs. **14,40,000/-** for SC (16%) was transferred to the College account by UGC on 07.12.2019 and utilization of the same as per allocations under budget head is complete. The annual report for the year 2019-2020 shall be sent.

College is yet to receive 1st Installment Non- Recurring grant of Rs. 7, 20,000/- for ST (8%) and Recurring grant of Rs. 12 Lakhs per year for remaining 4 years (Rs. 48 Lakhs). **Dr. Alka Dhondge** is working hard as Member Secretary of the Committee.








Graphical Presentation of Results 2020 (in Percentage)
