
#### Report of Certificate Course in Autodesk AutoCAD

The knowledge of CAD (Computer Aided Design) is a prerequisite tool for an interior designer. The knowledge of CAD is necessary as this is the language of expression for all types of 2D and 3D drawings. Students going for apprentice training in offices of architects and interior designers after the third year, need to have full knowledge of handling the software. The knowledge gained through this course is also needed to prepare project drawings in the subjects if Interior Design and Project in the third and fourth year of the curriculum. This certificate course is conducted once every year and is a precursor to the subject of Digital Applications. The course duration was 90 hours from 1/07/2023 to 28/03/2024 and was conducted in the computer lab of the department having desktops where AutoCAD 2014 and above versions are available. The explanation of commands is live where students can see and learn the command on the screen projected through LCD projector. Students simultaneously practice the command on their desktop. The classes were conducted twice a week and were included in the regular timetable of the department. A total of 25 students completed the course. The tutor for the course was Anjali Khote.

For conducting this course our college has an MoU with Astral Informatics Pvt. Ltd. Tutors for the course and maintenance of computers is taken care by Astral Informatics Pvt. Ltd. They are an authorized training centre for AUTODESK.


The art of lettering is an important skill desired in the field of interior design. All drawings done by the students of interior design need lettering on them. Text is an integral part of all drawings. Lettering skill is hence an essential skill required by all designers.

The outcome of the workshop was skill development in various types of letter types written manually. The syllabus of the workshop included fifteen different types of fonts like Gothic. City Blue Print, and Country Blue Print to name a few. A stationery kit containing Calligraphy pens, workbook and notebook etc was provided to all participants. The workbook containing all the 15 fonts was part of the kit. A test was taken for assessing the students and feedback was collected. A fee of Rs.1200 was charged per student. Resources were generated for the department through this certificate course.

# Department of Interior Design Report Skill Education in Artefacts

A skill development programme 'Artefactshop' was organized for III year students of Bachelor of Interior Design from 3/1/2024 to 10/1/2024. A total number of 24 students benefitted from the workshop. The aim of the workshop was to enable students to manufacture artefacts needed for interiors from reconstituted wood. The expected outcome was actual production of artefacts in the workshop. The workshop was divided in 3 phase. In the first phase an introduction to the material MDF (medium density fiberboard) its market availability, properties and tools and methods of handling and were given. In the second phase the products were manufactured in the workshop with the assistance of a carpenter. To manufacture the products, students were given in-depth knowledge about tools like hand saw. drill, files and sanding machine, Joinery and fitting of the artefacts was done by the students by applying knowledge gained in the first phase of the workshop. In the third phase the products was finished by using acrylic paint and sealer coat. The third phase was guided by an artist who was an expert in the field of handling paints. The finished products were packed for the purpose of sale in kruti exhibition. The workshop was an endeavour towards skill education and entrepreneurship development. Dr. Rijuta Bapat was the convenor for the workshop.



#### REPORT -- KRUTI WORKSHOP BEADING ACCESSORIES 2023-2024

Second year students were involved and guided in an observation and resourceful activity in a Workshop on "Beading Accessories and artefacts" from 4<sup>TH</sup>jan to 10<sup>th</sup>jan 2024. In this workshop students were briefed about the importance of using wooden beading to makeartefacts, and accessories which could be used also used were upcycled or natural materials and thus minimize waste and put to better use.

Prior to the commencement of the workshop, an overview of various productswas given and a few examples were demonstrated. Students were also shown how combining two or three materials which were normally discarded as trash because they are broken, disused, disfigured or worn out with creativity and imagination can be transform a product into useful and beautiful objects thus increasing their life. Examples where many different compatible materials, their combinations along with simple methods using waste materials to create innovative items were shown.

The first two days were given for the preparations and ideas which were generated during brainstorming and conceptual development stages were converted into material requirement. Waste materials had been sourced from the environment. Two products per The next four days were dedicated for making the student was the targeted outcome. products, increasing their durability and appeal and finally finishing the products. The workshop resulted in each participant generating a few ideas and creating two unique and useful products with aesthetic value viz wall hanging, artefacts, flower vases, pen holders, lamps, baskets, clocks and many more.

Materials used were fabric, tissue, newspapers, stones, pebbles, ropes, sticks, twigs,

bangles, cartons, beads, wires, sewing frames, jeans.

#### Report on Skill-Education (SkEd Level I) Certificate Course ON "FINANCIAL AWARENESS AND INVESTMENT PLANNING"

The Faculty of Commerce & Management of L.A.D. & Smt. R.P. College for Women, Nagpur had organized a week long Skill-Education (SkEd Level I) wrokshop on "Financial Awareness and Investment Planning" (FAIP) in G6 classroom of the college. The course initiated under the guidance of Dr. Pooja Pathak, Principal & Dr. Bhavana Khapekar, Head, Faculty of Commerce & Management & Co-ordinator of the program. SkEd aims to satisfy the core needs of students, recent graduates and experienced professionals. Inauguration of the course was held on 18 March, 2024. Dr. Bhavana Khapekar felicitated the Chief Guest, Mr. Shailesh Sandel, Faculty of Money Bee Institute Pvt. Ltd, Nagpur. She also encouraged the students to participate actively in the workshop. Introductory remarks were made by Dr. Usha Daigavane, Convenor of SkEd Level I.

In all 108 students and faculty members registered for the course. Prominently present on the occasion were entire fraternity of Commerce and Management who worked hard for the success of the event.





18 March 2024, first day of SkEd Level I was addressed by Mr. Shailesh Sandel. He started the session with emphasizing on the importance of financial awareness and financial planning in everyone's life. He started with comparing the common investment options. It was found that investing in securities lead to high returns when compared to other options. He clarified the concept and power of compounding, time value of money and the formulas of the same. Further he discussed the scope of MS-EXCEL in today's world that how a proficiency of this

soft skill brings value to resume and in employ ability competency of a person. A video on stock market before 1980s was shared to get an idea about the buying and selling of shares in 1980s.

19 March 2024, second day of SkEd Level I was continued by Mr. Shailesh Sandel. The day began with an outline of the secondary market- BSE and NSE, India's two major stock markets. He discussed qualitative characteristics such as business understanding, company history, brand value, and brand existence, as well as quantitative aspects such as a company's balance sheet and income statement. Students asked questions, which he replied enthusiastically.

On 20 March 2024, third day of SkEd Level-I, Ms. Shivani Dani, Director of Money Bee Institute Pvt. Ltd, Nagpur, was the facilitator. She discussed on mutual funds, which are an indirect way to invest in the stock market, as well as the Sensex and Nifty. A brief outline of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI), which regulates mutual funds, was delivered. She elaborates that one can start their investment with small amount of Rs.10 per day through bank for long period and gain such an amount which will be useful for higher studies afterwards. Students were asked a few questions regarding the stock exchange and mutual fund business so that they could learn more about the subject.

21 March 2024, fourth day of SkEd Level I was addressed by Mr. Shailesh Sandel.who elucidated the concept of fundamental analysis, emphasizing its significance in investment decision-making. Fundamental analysis involves evaluating a security's intrinsic value by examining related economic, financial, and other qualitative and quantitative factors. The session discussed the top-down approach in investment analysis, which involves evaluating the macroeconomic environment before focusing on specific sectors or companies. This holistic approach helps investors in making informed decisions aligned with broader economic trends. Contrasting the top-down approach, the bottom-up approach involves analyzing individual stocks based on their fundamental attributes, regardless of broader market trends. The workshop delved into understanding key monetary policy tools such as CRR, SLR, Repo, and Reverse Repo rates.

22 March 2024, fifth day of SkEd Level I was taken by Mr. Shailesh Sandel. He presented the concept of taxation and the two types of taxation, namely, long-term capital gain tax and short-term capital gain tax. He offered a quick overview of mutual fund taxation and the ELS

Scheme (Equity Link Savings Scheme). The Rupee Cost Averaging Approach, in which a fixed amount of money is invested at regular intervals, was also discussed. Excel formulas such as the XIRR and the Power of Compounding were also thoroughly explained.

23 March 2024, sixth day of SkEd Level I was addressed by Mr. Shailesh Sandel. The final day of the workshop started with the concept of tax. He also enlighten students about income tax returns and the importance of income tax returns. The students positively answered to the questions by the speaker and got to know much about taxes.

At the end of the programme, a feedback session of SkEd Level I was conducted by Dr. Usha Daigavane Convenor of the program. Feedback Session was open for student participants & staff. Representative from B.Com, B.B.A. & B.C.C.A gave individual feedback on all the sessions. They shared that they gained practical knowledge about Stock Market, Mutual Funds, On-line trading, etc. and learnt many ways to save. They felt more confident and enthusiastic to build their career in investment related fields. Teachers suggested students to participate more in such events. Dr. Bhavana Khapekar was appreciative of the orderly way course was arranged and motivated students for further participation. All teachers of Faculty of Commerce & Management were also present.


#### 22<sup>nd</sup> Feb. to 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2024- Workshop on Advanced Design Drapes


#### 27th March to 6th April 2024- Workshop on Accessory Design:
