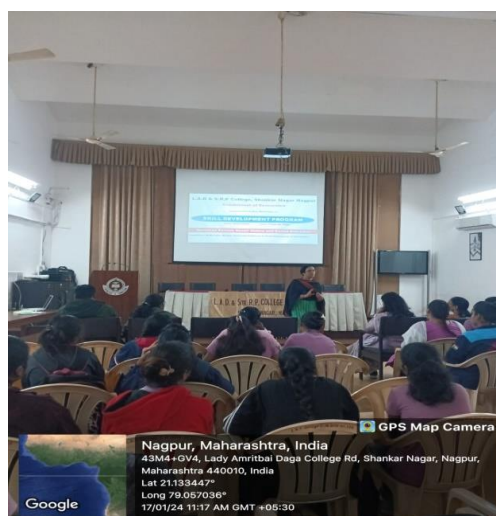

Seminar on: "India and the World 2024: Challenges & Opportunities"

29th January 2024

On the 29th of January, 2024, a seminar on "India and the World 2024: Challenges & Opportunities" was conducted in the Conference Hall of L.A.D. College, Shankar Nagar Campus. The guest speaker was Prof. Sayan Banerjee from IMT Nagpur, spoke about the analysis of India's current economic landscape and its global standing.

Prof. Banerjee began by stating India's economy in 2024. He highlighted the booming stock market, infrastructure development, the government's steps in improving the business environment, and India's GDP growth, which was even more than the United States and China. Prof. Banerjee then discussed the challenges ahead - the declining investment, both domestic and foreign in Indian economy.

The seminar also offered a glimpse into the global landscape of 2024. Prof. Banerjee explained ongoing conflicts and threats, from geopolitical tensions to environmental crises and also addressed immediate risks such as China's economic slowdown and the resurgence of El Nino-induced disruptions. He identified technology, particularly artificial intelligence, as a wildcard shaping the future. He provided an understanding of the complex relationship between the US and China, highlighting their roles as stabilizing forces during global unrest.

Total 120 students attended the seminar. Overall, the seminar was an insightful journey through India's economic position in the world and the challenges it faces. His explanations and analysis left the audience eager to know more about global economics and question it.

Fish Farm Visit to Fish Seed Production Unit, College of Fishery Sciences,
Telangkhedi, Nagpur
Dt. 08-09-2023

Department of Zoology of L.A.D. & Smt. R.P. College for Women, Nagpur, had arranged a study Tour for the students B.Sc. –III, V of the Faculty of Science.

The study tour to Fish farm is mentioned in the syllabus of Semester-V of the subject Zoology. But to study the other required parameters, to establish a fish farm, like Topography, Water & Soil requirement, Weather conditions, this study tour was arranged for all science students.

Total 81 Students visited the Fish Seed Production Unit of College of Fishery Sciences, Telangkhedi, Nagpur on 08-09-2023. Dr. Nirzar Kulkarni, A Fish Scientist explained various aspects of Pisciculture like the preliminary requisites of land needed for the fish farm as Topography, Water & Soil requirement, weather conditions, care to be taken, species required for fish culture, fish diseases, Construction of various fish ponds as Breeding ponds, Hatcheries, Nursery, Rearing ponds, etc. He demonstrated the working of Chinese Hatchery. Students experienced the processing and harvesting techniques of fishes marketing also. Students also got benefited with the first-hand experience of handling all the stages of fish life cycle from spawning to adult. They collected the water and soil samples to study further aspects. 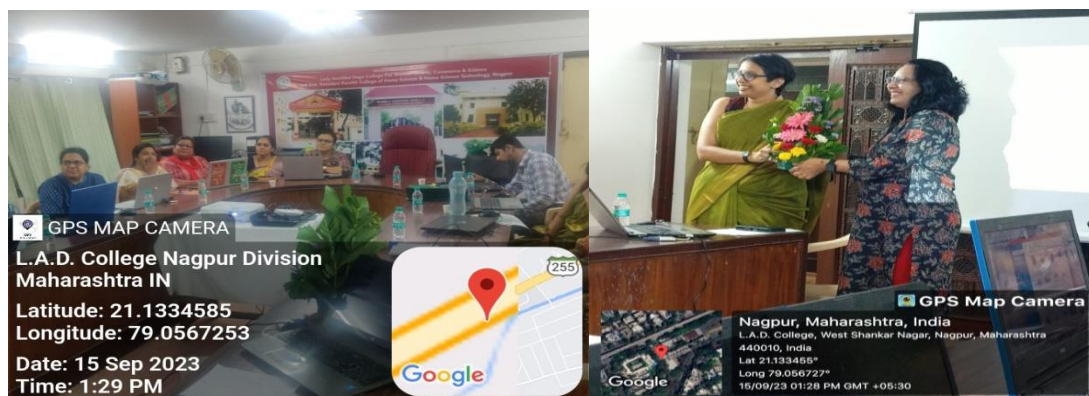




ORIGIN SOFTWARE WORKSHOP CONDUCTED BY IRICH

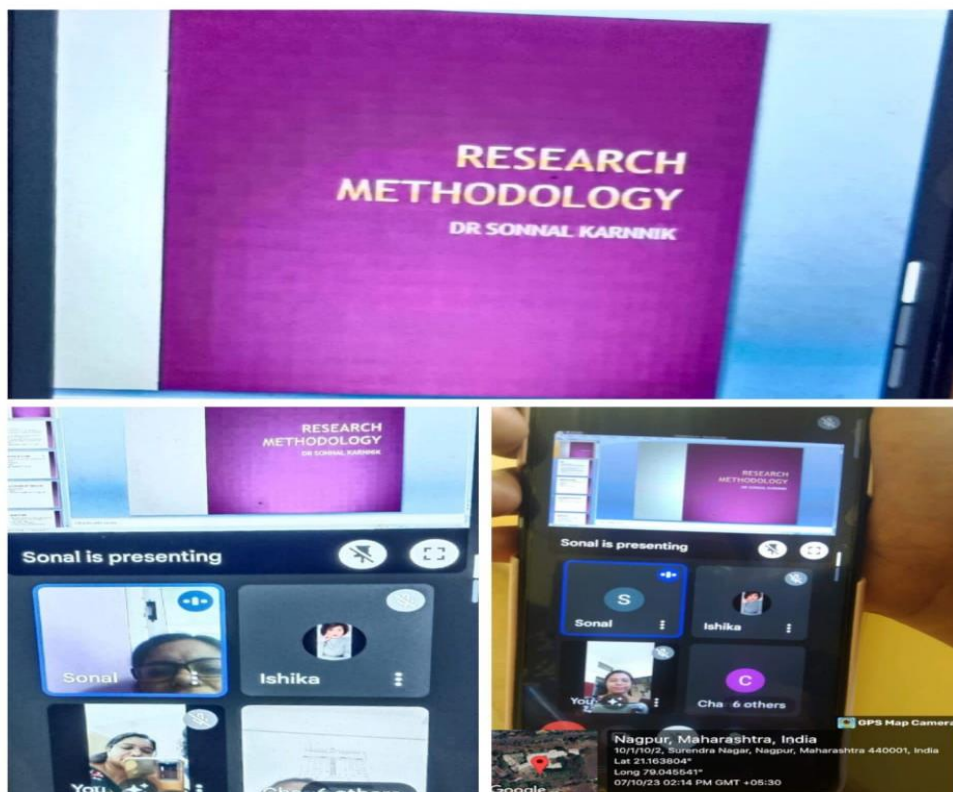

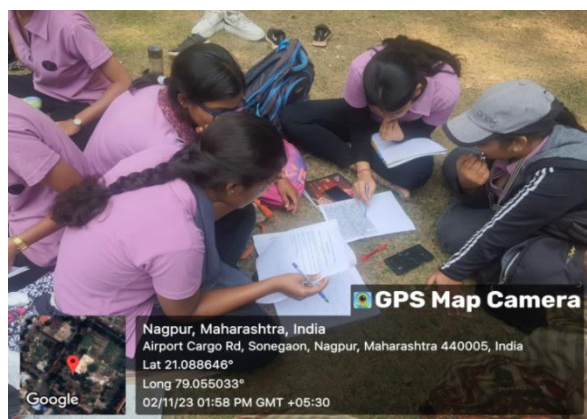
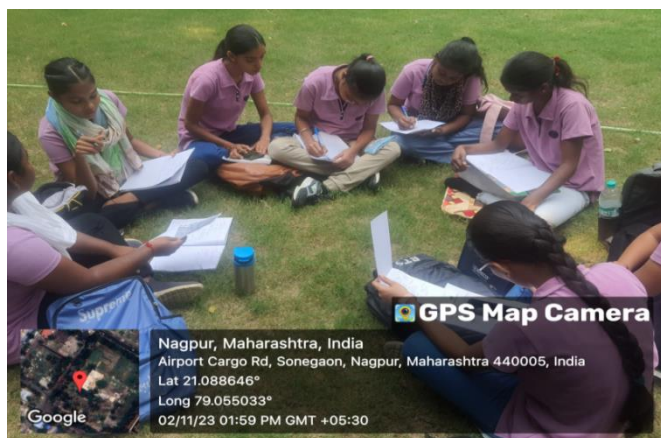
A short project titled, "A Study of Weather Instruments at Regional Meteorological Centre, Nagpur" has been carried out during the study visit at regional meteorological Centre, Nagpur airport on 02nd November 2023.

Firstly, Students have been asked to locate RMC in the map of Nagpur city. After discussions with the RMC officers and scientists and also after visiting all the sections viz. surface observatory, main observatory, roof observatory, WBRT section and Doppler Radar section of RMC, students have been asked to fill the worksheets provided to them.

Students have asked their queries with the officials of RMC. On the basis of their observations and discussions, they filled details of the structure and functioning of each instrument and write its use in knowing weather data. Other associated information related with each weather instrument has been written by students in detail on the given worksheets.

In this process students learnt the methodology of observation and discussion for obtaining correct information. By this activity students also got aware about the process of weather data collection, This helped in enhancing their understanding of weather instruments and working pattern of meteorological centre.

Twenty one students participated in this project.

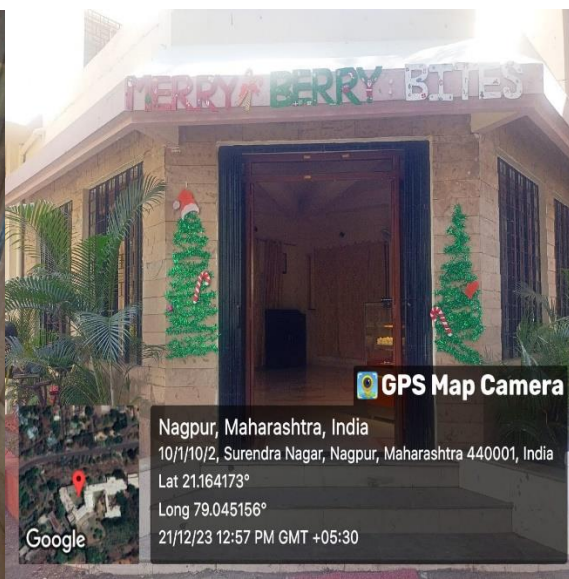




CAKE FAIR

He also told us about the exams which require basic education qualification i.e. based on SSC (IBPS PO, SSC CHSL, RRB NTPC, Civil Service Examination, Defence Exams, etc) also about exams which requires HSC as minimum education qualification (NDAS, SSC, RRB, SSC CHSL, UPSC, RBI, etc).Further in exams conducted by central government/ Level sir mainly focused on the banking sector and motivated us to be aware of the opportunities offered by them and study hard to grab them. 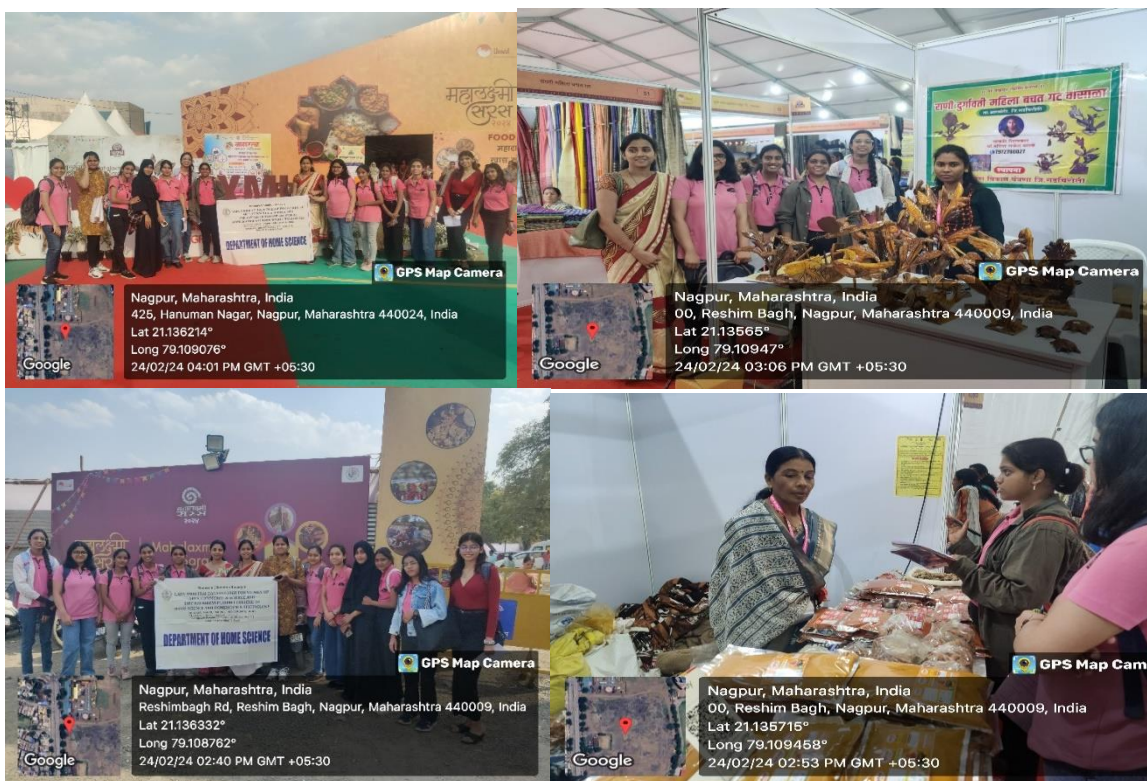

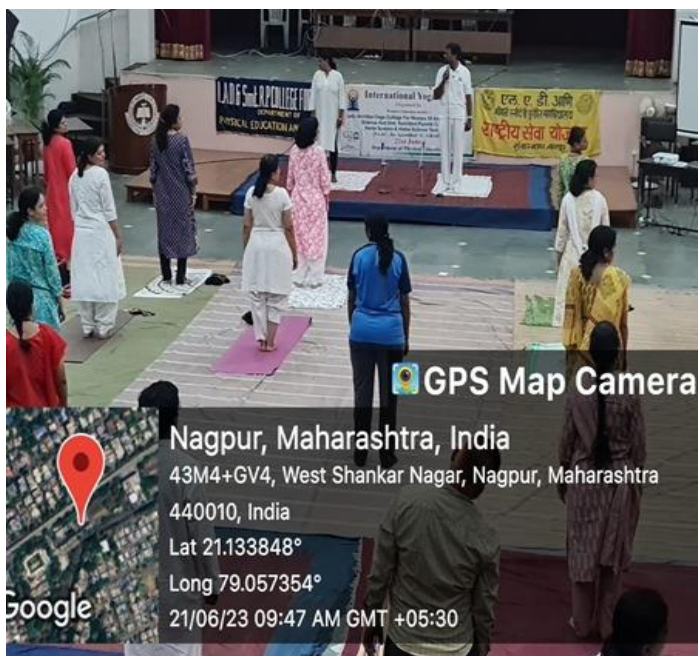

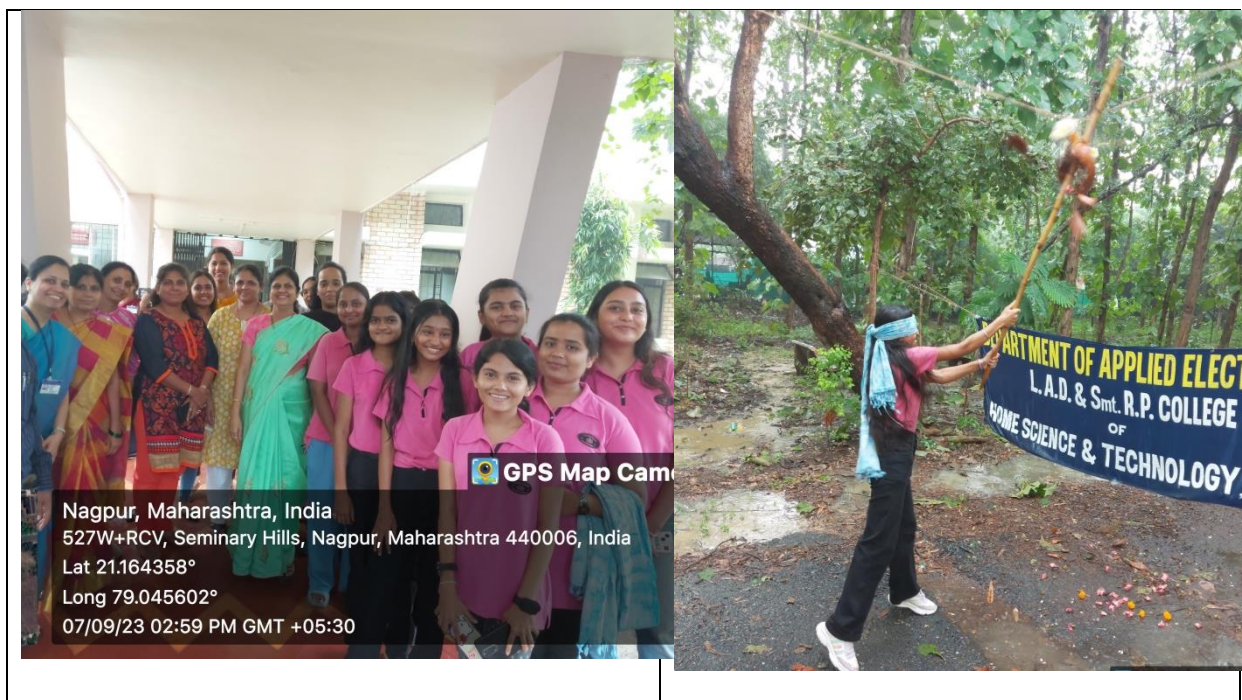
Report of Janmashtami Celebration – 7 September 2023

Teachers from various departments attended the programme.

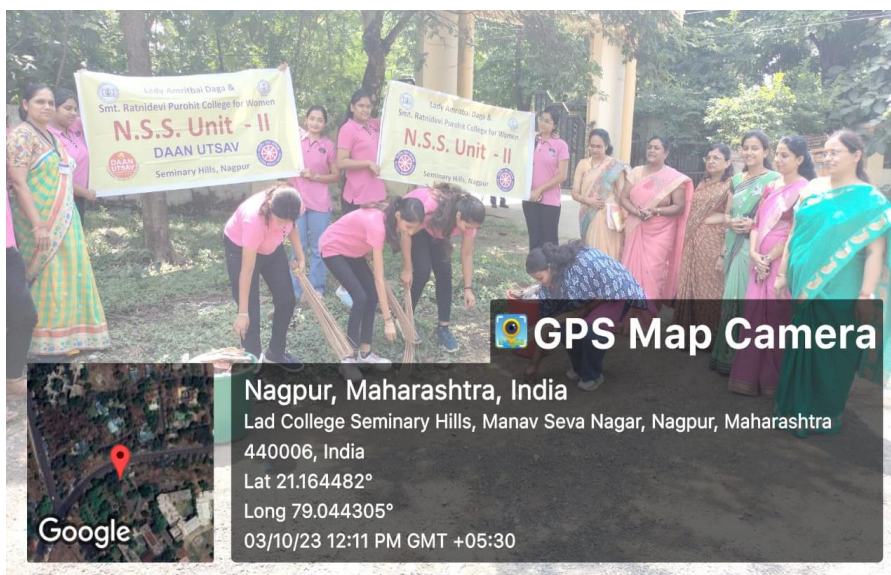




DAAN UTSAV 2023

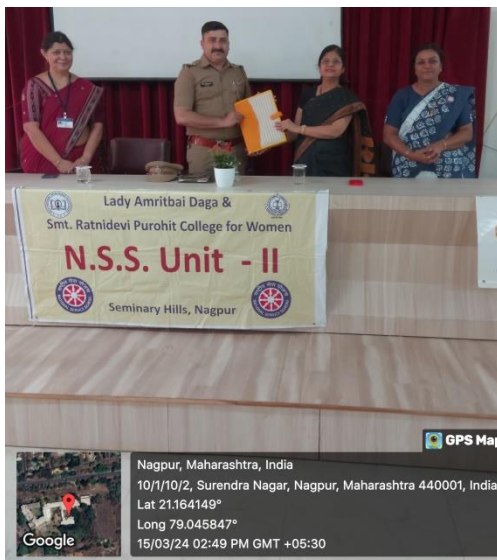




NSS Unit II celebrated International Women's Day in D J Deshmukh Hall on Friday, 15 March 2024 at 2:30 p.m.

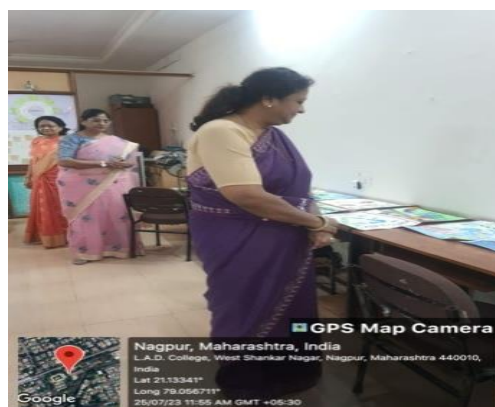

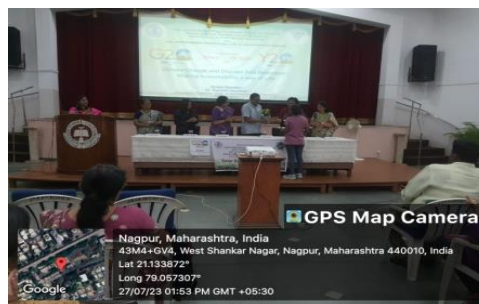

Report

A field visit was carried out with objectives-

- to develop insight about geomorphic phenomenon and process
- to identify features and concept of applied geomorphology and
- to develop observation skills

Geomorphic features of Kanhan River Valley and surrounding region was investigated for understanding geomorphology and work of river. An intensive field investigation was carried out to study geomorphology.. The observation reveals that the area is dominated by Deccan Trap basalt and associated relief. Metamorphism process was initiated in the region but was not completed as certain outcrop with variations was observed. Fine material was observed in river bed and at banks of the river. Floral weathering was also observed. While observing the valley students collected various rock pieces.

A visit to ***Deolapar Cow Research Centre*** was also carried out during study visit. It is a Non-Government Organization on a mission to rekindle the age-old bond between humans and cows. The main objective of the centre is to do research with cow projects and its benefits for human and nature. The centre is having approximately 700 cows. Along with other centre it has Cow Based Panchagavya Ayurved centre. Panchagavya Ayurveda is a holistic healing system that incorporates five key elements obtained from the cow – milk, ghee, curd, urine, and dung. Each of these components carries unique healing properties and is carefully prepared to unlock their full potential. Students were guided about functioning of various units. With this visit students learnt about significance of cow in Indian culture and importance of cow product in ayurved for healthy life.

A short projecton life of the Gond tribe was carried out at village Chorbahuli. It is located in Ramtek Taluka of Nagpur district, The people were migrated from Madhya Pradesh and Chhatisgarh.
