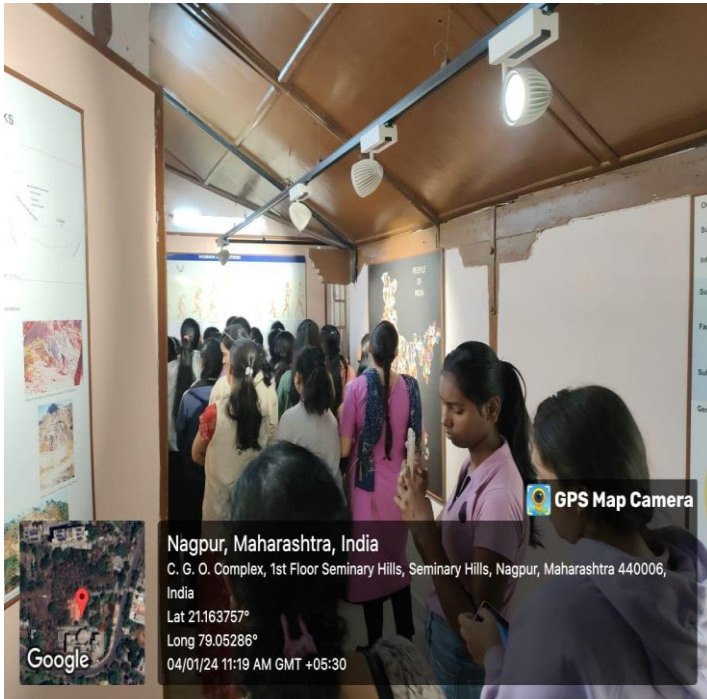

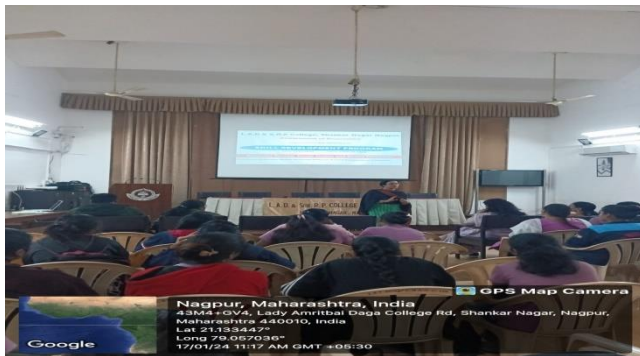

L.A.D & Smt R.P College for Women had hosted an invited talk show on the 22 February, 2024 with the co-founders of the Brand ‘SUTA’ along with Dr Ruta Dharmadikari (HOD, Dept of English) who welcomed the guests and carried out a question- answer session. The program aimed to help students by imparting ideas about the inception and start of any business, its marketing and branding strategies. The interactive session provided lot of information and satisfied the queries invoked by the participants.

Launched in 2016, ‘SUTA’ was the brainchild of sisters Sujata (SU) and Taniya (TA) Biswas. They had the dream of reinstating the traditional saree as the go-to daily wear. Handcrafted by over 50 weavers from across the country, Suta sarees always come with a unique personal touch. Over the last few years, the Suta brand has become well-established in the traditional Indian wear segment. Set on positively impacting weaver and artisan communities, they ensure that their traditional crafts thrive and are known primarily for their exquisite range of cotton sarees, in varieties of jamdani weave, mulmul, malkesh, banarasi, amongst others, Suta is a venture with a cause. The brand is largely known for its range of cotton sarees from different traditions, but also work with the purest mulberry silk as well, handloom ikats and linen, amongst others. On silk and cotton, Suta employs techniques like hand batik, block-printing, embroidery, etc. Despite having no background in fashion or textiles, the entrepreneurs felt a strong urge to start a brand that would positively impact the weaver and artisan community and revive the dying art forms of India. Presently they have more than 17,000 [weavers](#) and artisans who work on a contractual basis.

What began as a passion project to explore creative curiosities and personal inspirations has in nearly seven years turned into a business that has generated about Rs 72 crores in revenue and created a “happy place” for over 280 full-time employees.

According to the owners, “Suta is an amalgamation of collective desire to make a positive impact on-ground to ensure the legacies of precious crafts and weaves finding a place in the modern context,” . The brand has recently launched a line of men’s wear like kurta and is soon getting into women’s kurtas. In addition, the venture is already into loungewear, home decor, handbags, jewellery, etc.

The candid conversation was indeed an insightful event wherein the faculties as well as the students of the college, in particular Master of Fashion Designing students interacted and received valuable inputs about how to conceptualize and build up brands and was definitely a very interesting session for our budding entrepreneurs.

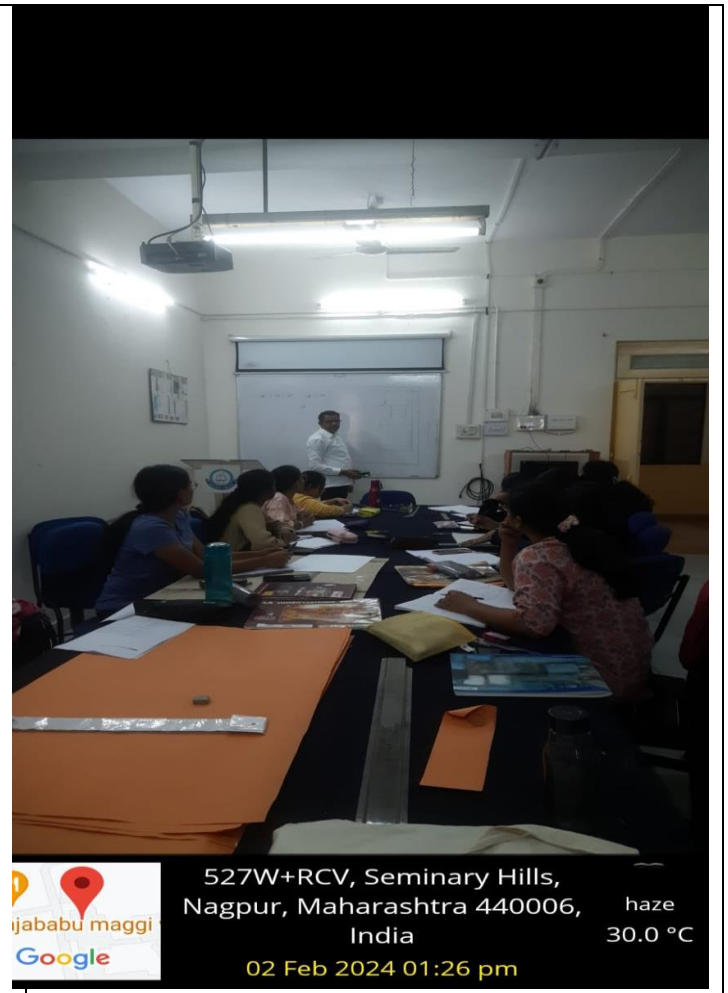
### 2<sup>nd</sup> Feb. to 28<sup>th</sup> February 2024- Workshop on Men's Wear

**Visit to Government Food and Drug administration Laboratory, Nagpur**

Department of Chemistry organised one day study visit with 19 students of Bsc I year, Sem I Chemistry to Government Food and Drug administration Laboratory, Nagpur on 23-02-2024 along with respective teachers. The Food and Drug Administration (FDA) is a government organization which is responsible for protecting the public health by assuring the safety, efficacy, and security of human and veterinary drugs, biological products, medical devices, our nation's food supply, cosmetics, and products that emit radiation. The Primary objective of this Administration is to implement various Acts for the control of quality of Drugs & Cosmetics and Safety of Food.

Senior Analyst of FDA, Nagpur Mr. Kautkar Sir and Ms. Chawan Madam explained process of sample testing thoroughly from Sample collection, coding, analysis, food and drug adulteration, if sample found suspected then what would be the legal approach.
